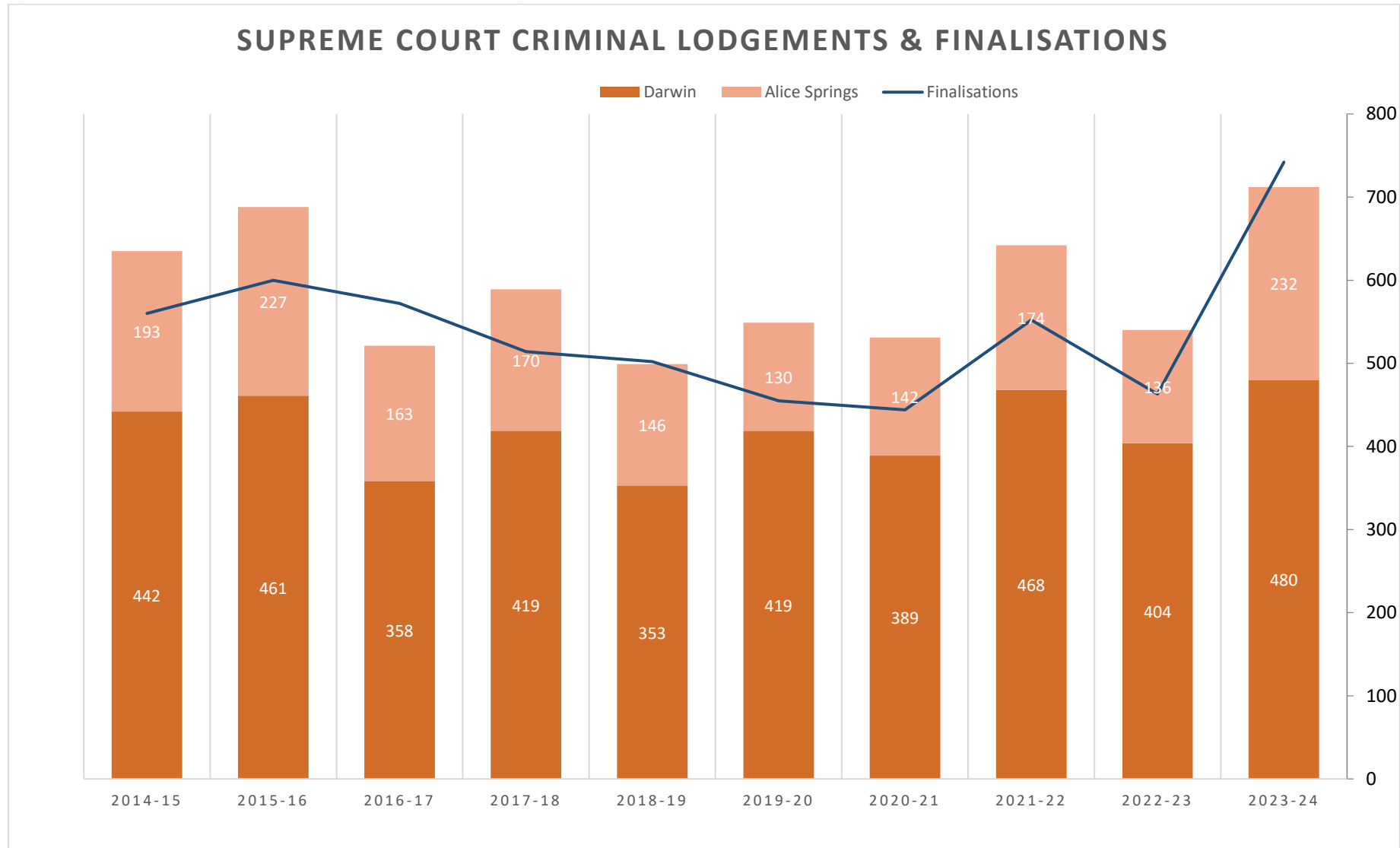

Figures for 2023-24 based on data to end December extrapolated to end of year



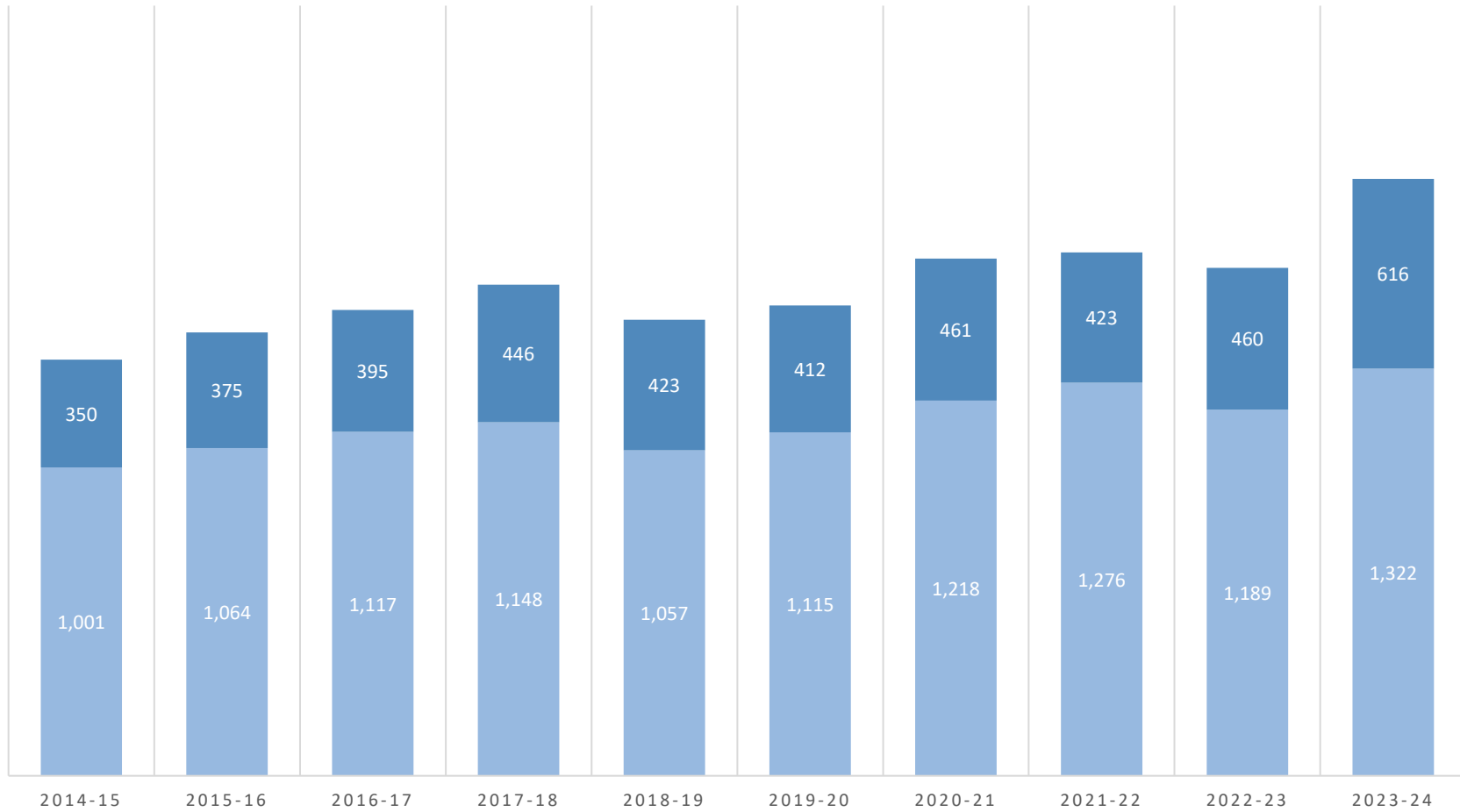

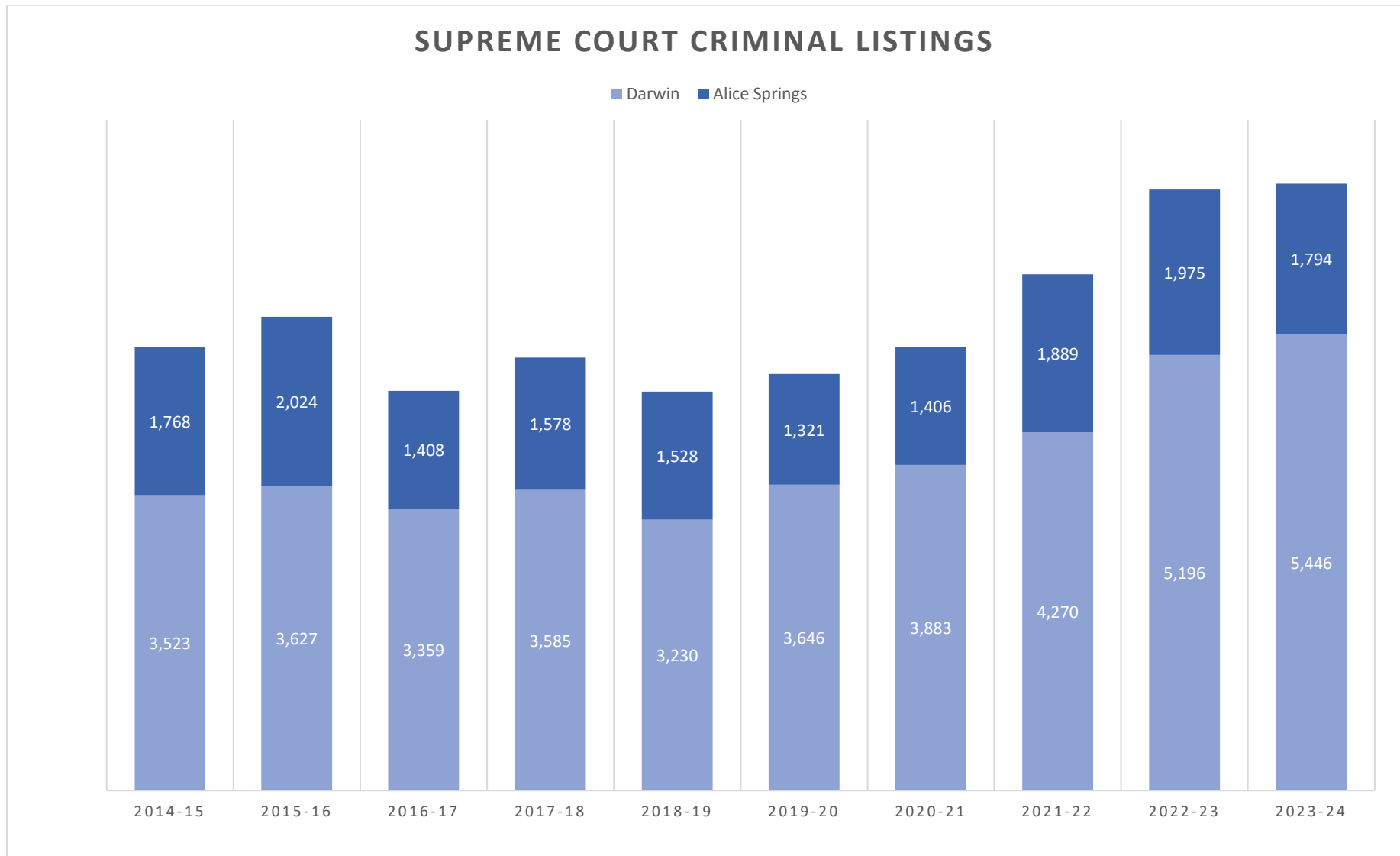

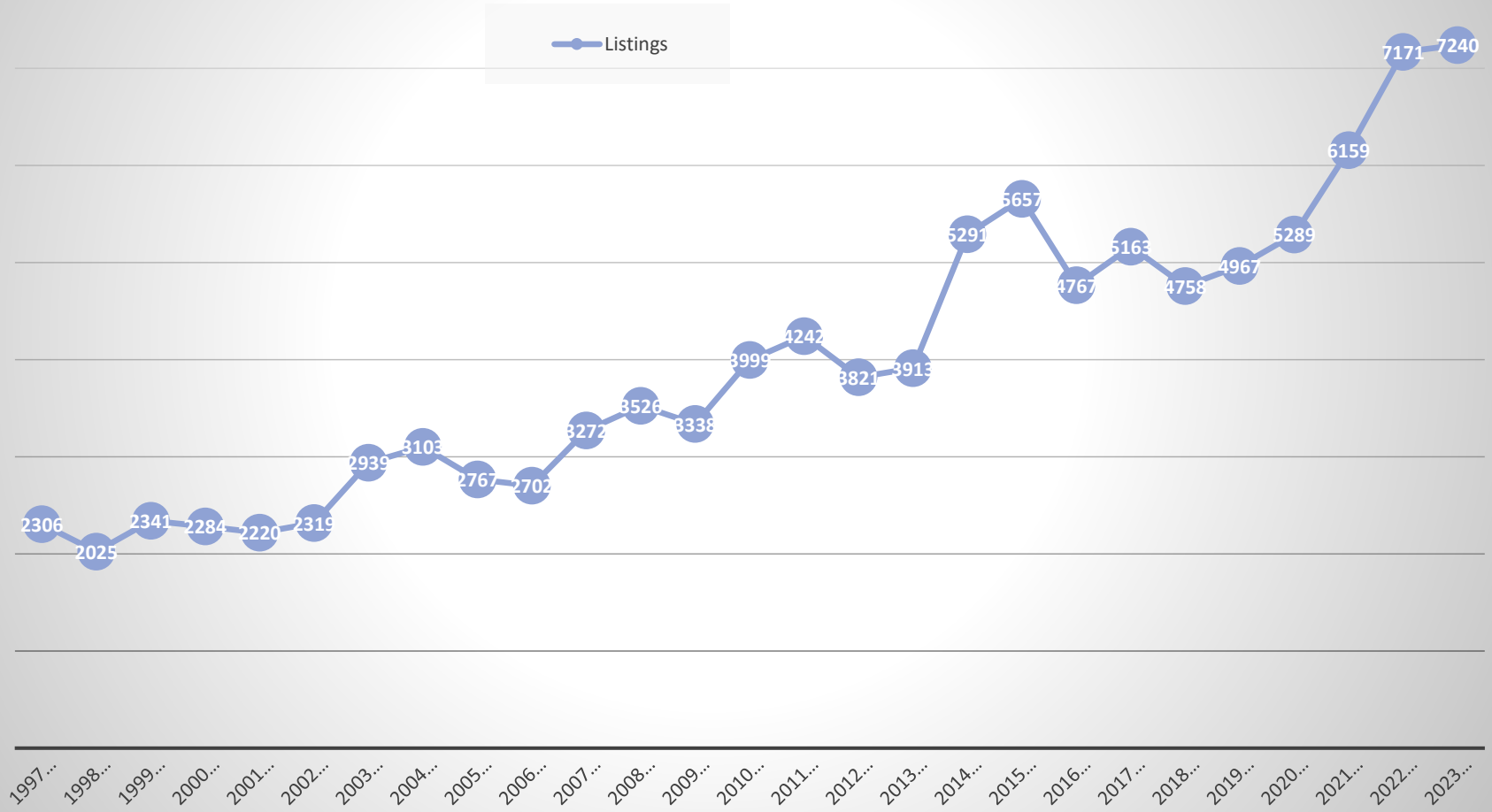

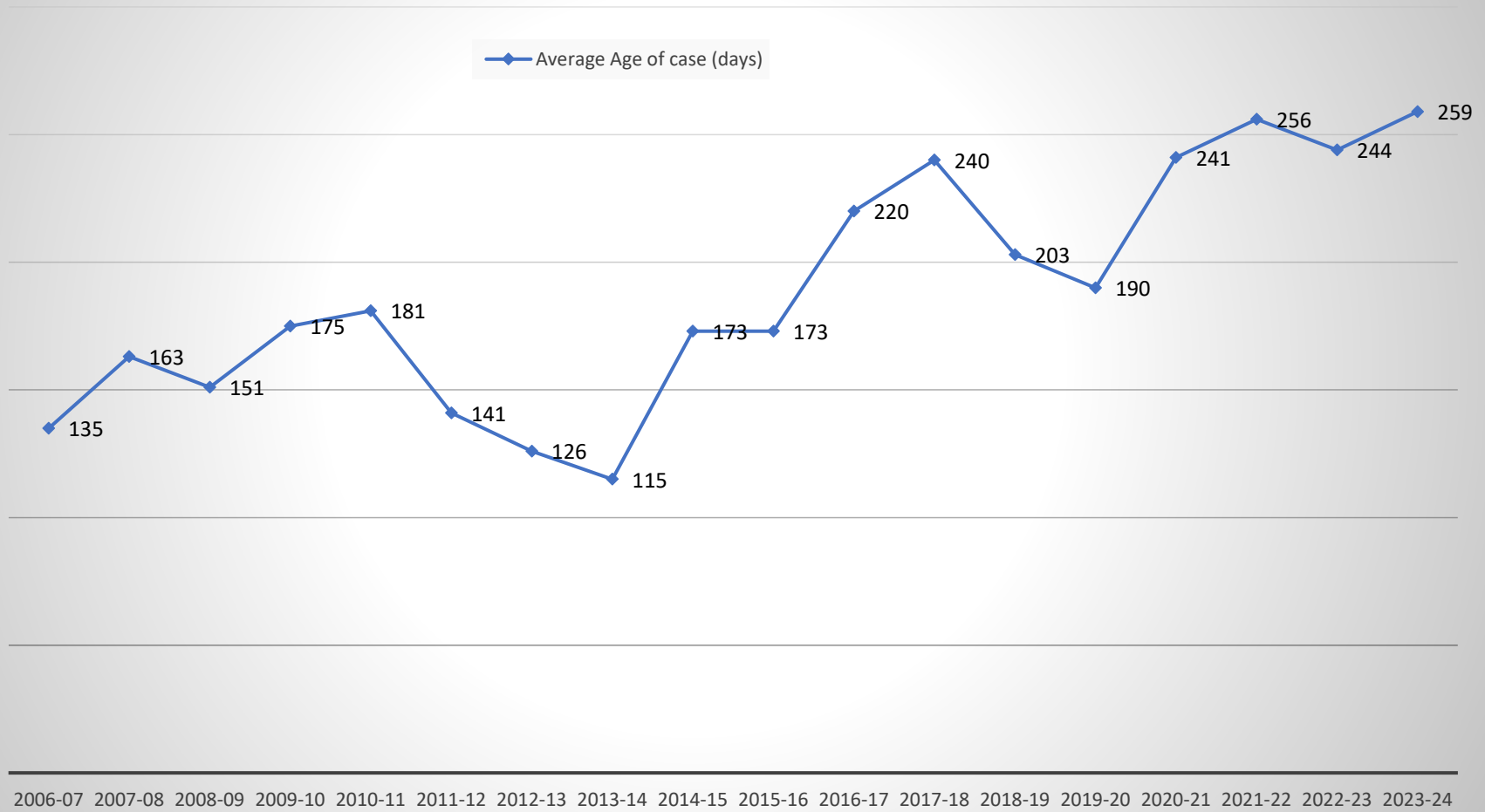

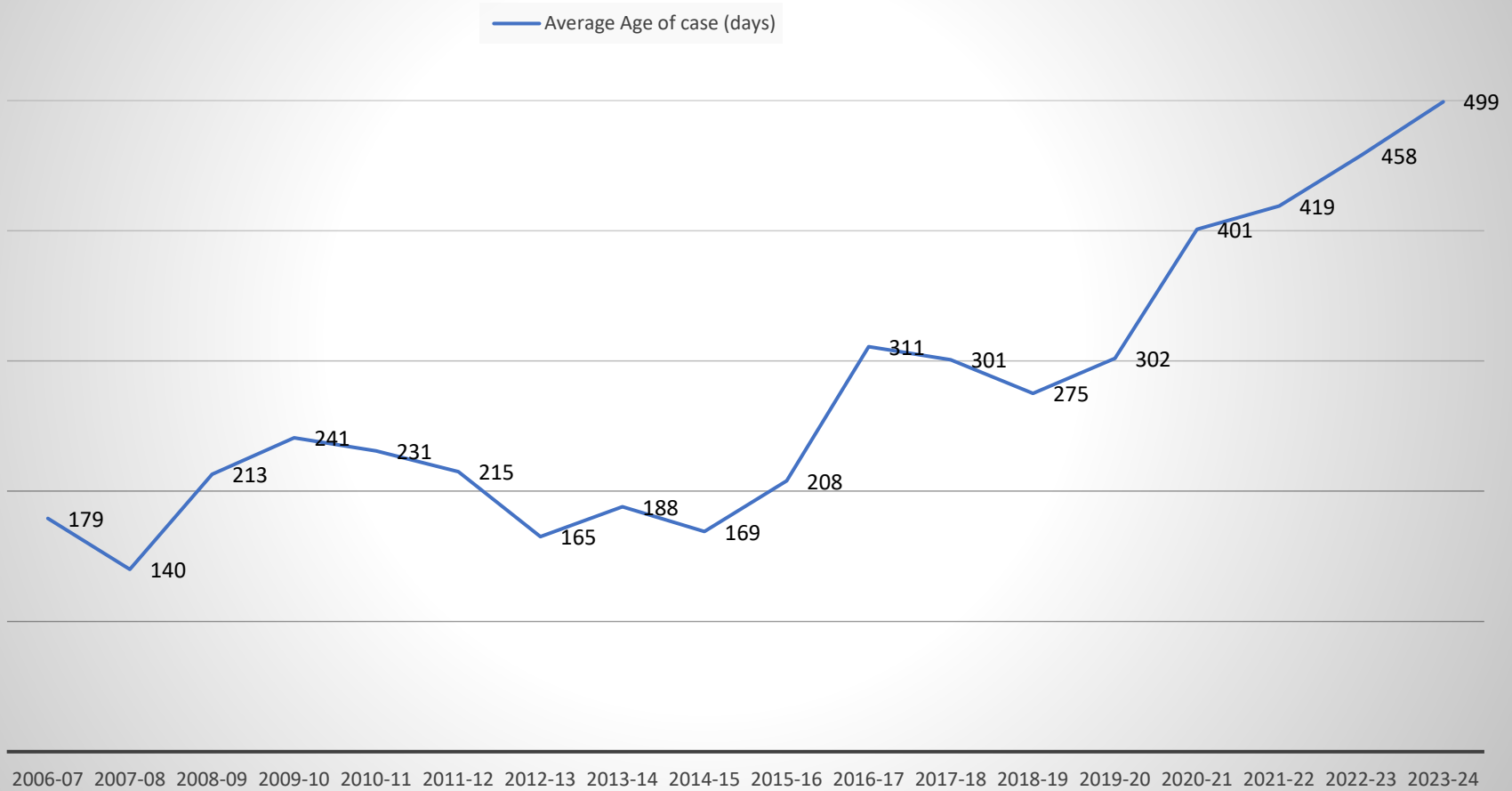

## Supreme Court average time between first mention and finalisation

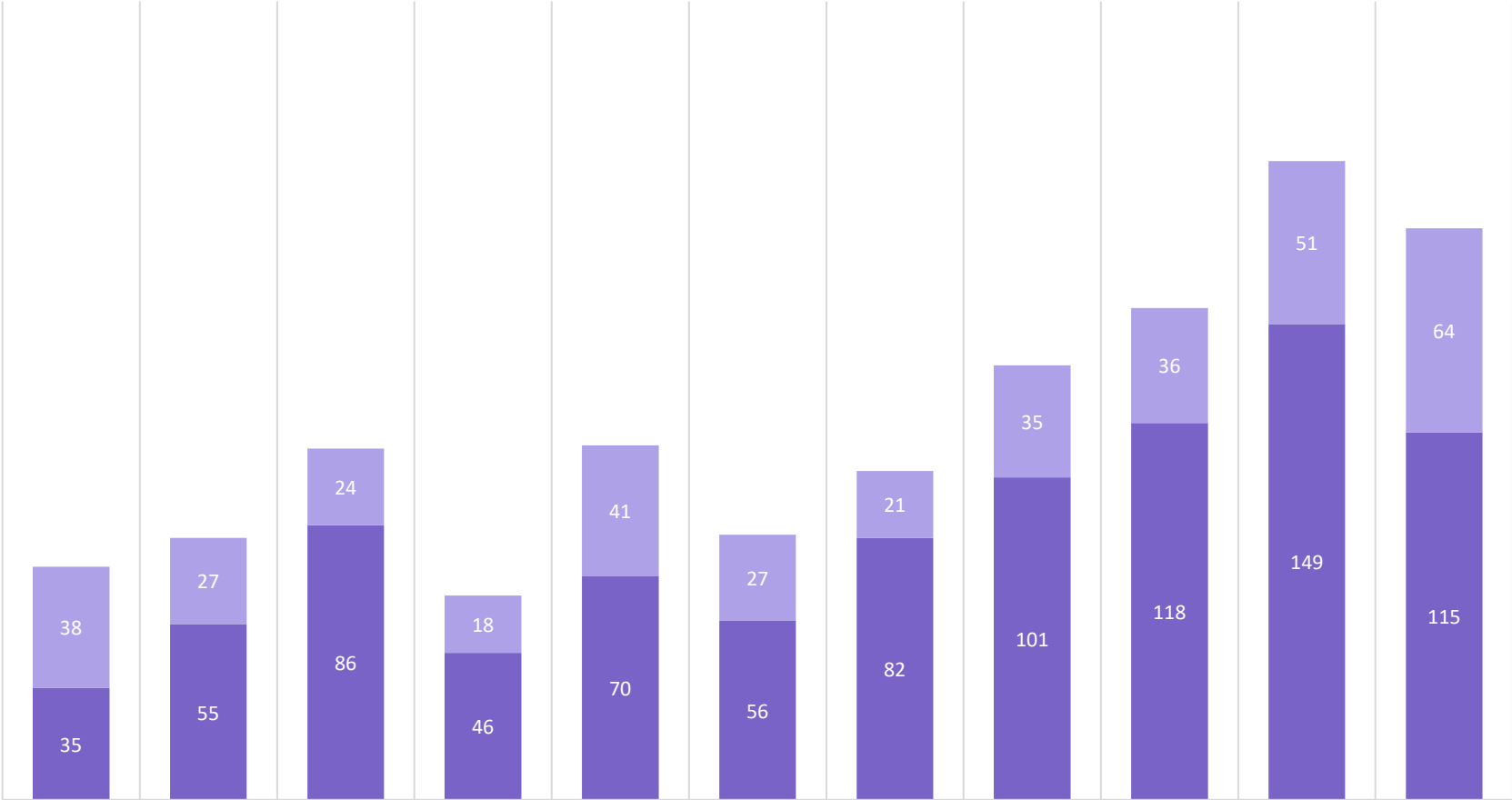


## Supreme Court average time between initiation and trial date

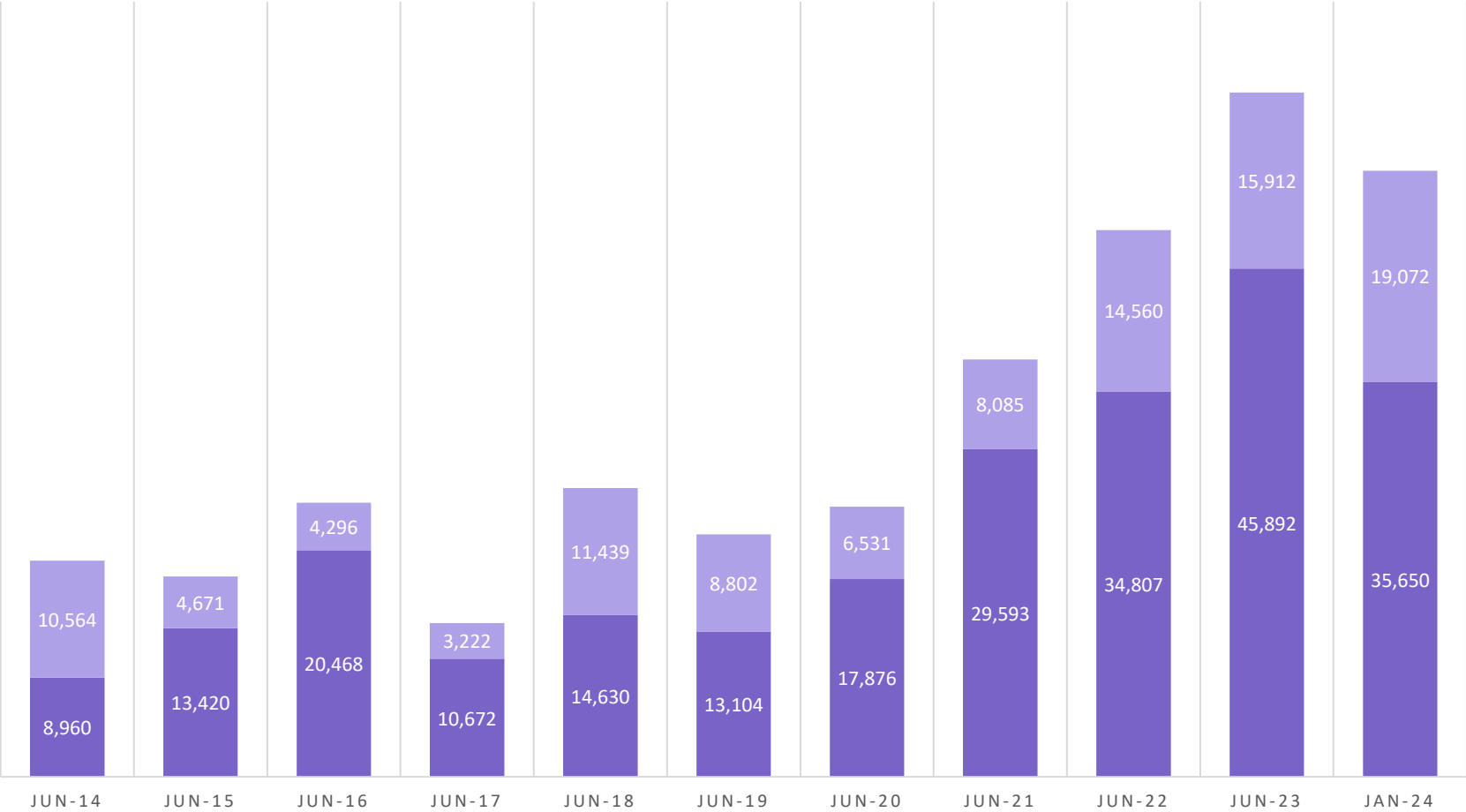


## AVERAGE REMAND TIME (DAYS)



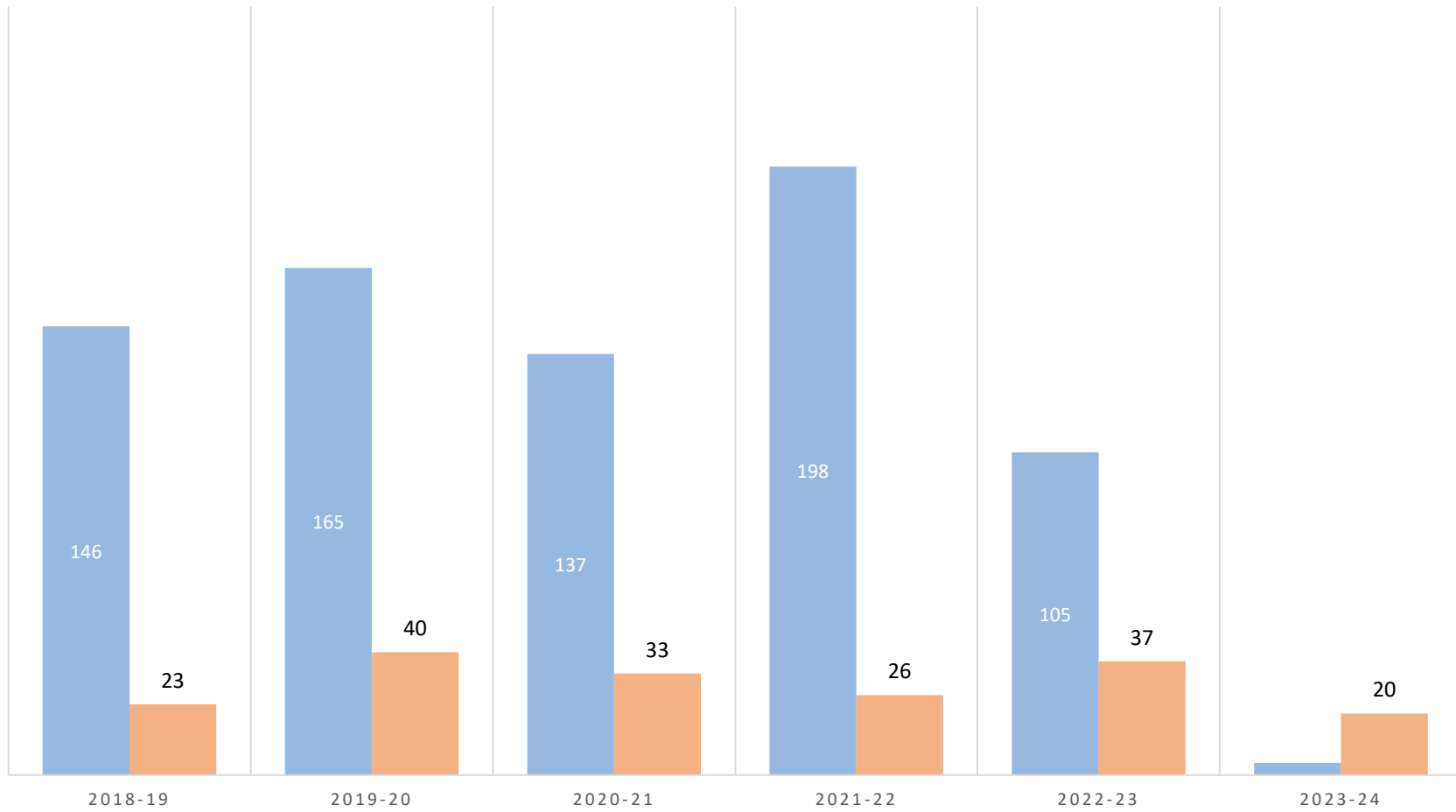
# ACCUMULATED SUPREME COURT REMAND DAYS

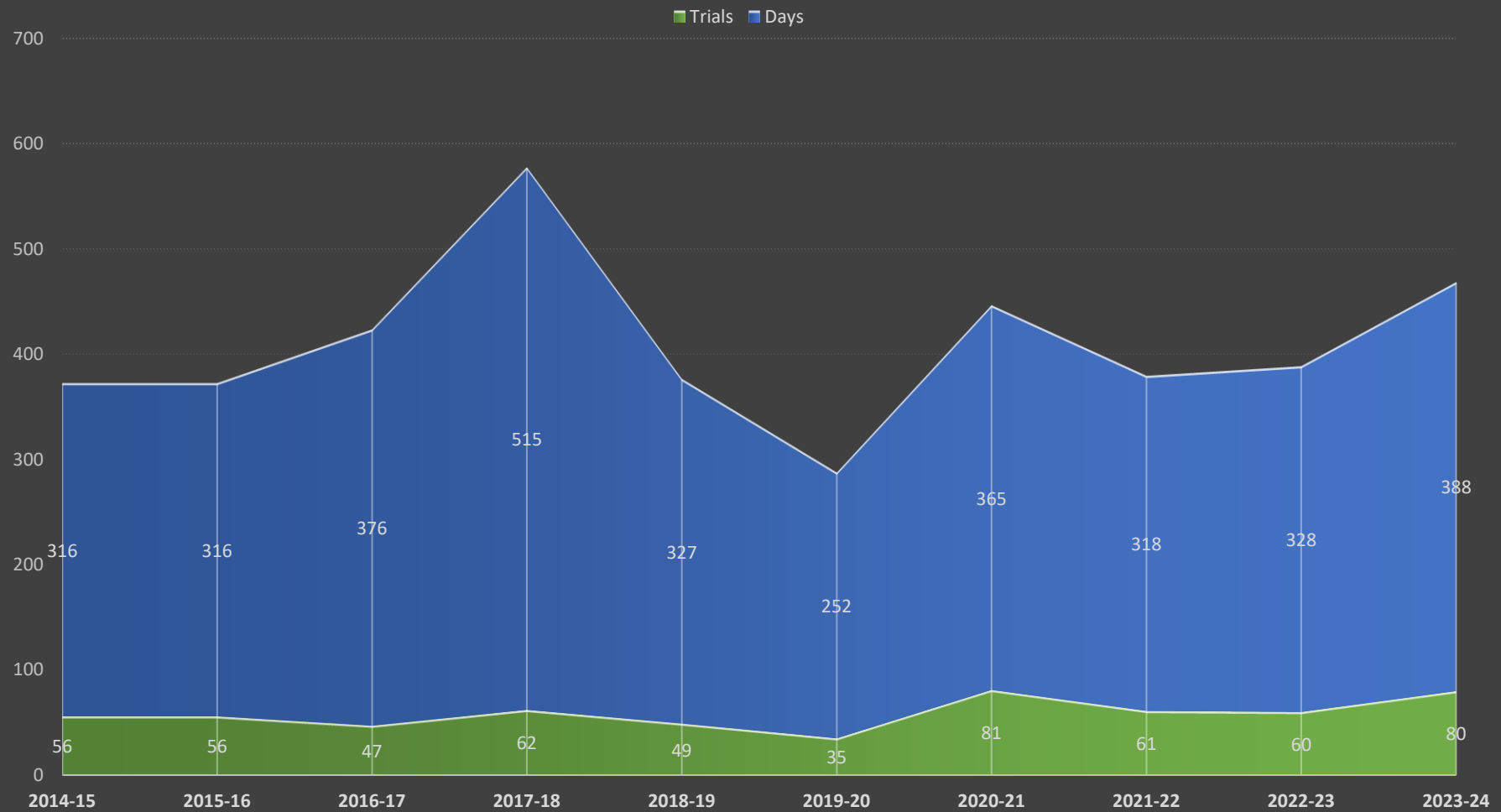


## SUPREME COURT TRIALS VACATED (INDICATIVE DATA ONLY)

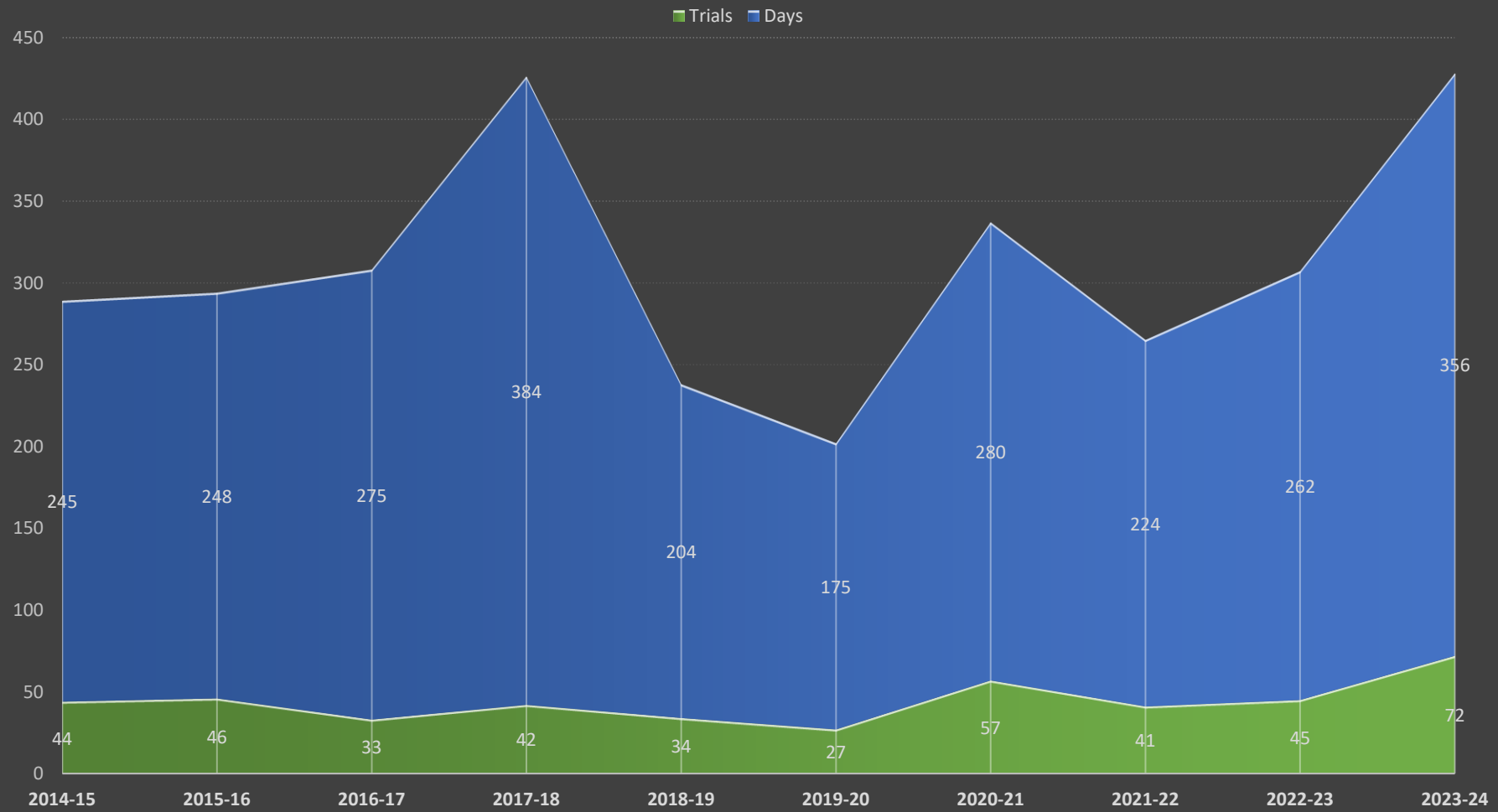

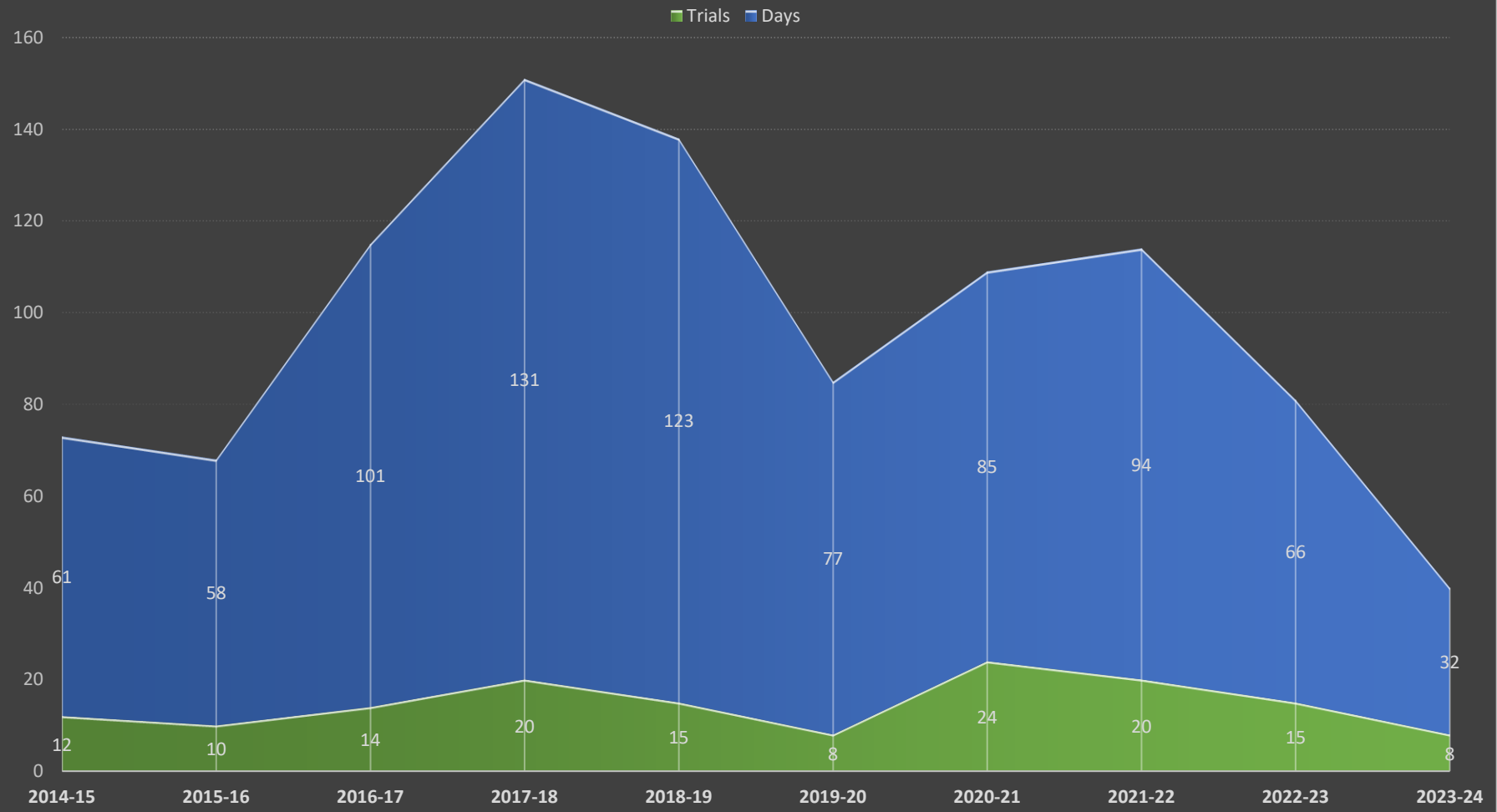
# Supreme Court JURY DATA - NT



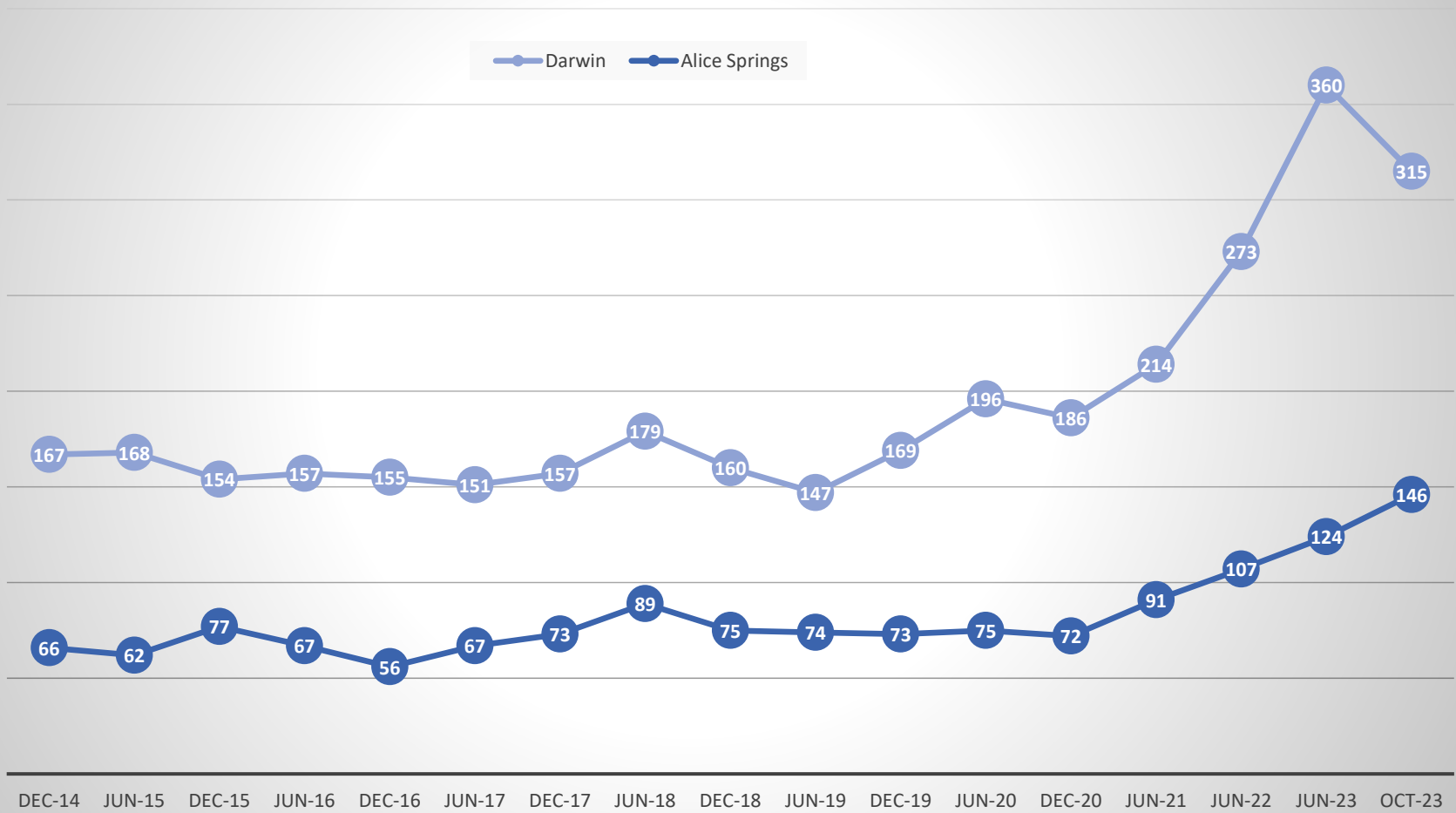
# Supreme Court JURY DATA - DARWIN



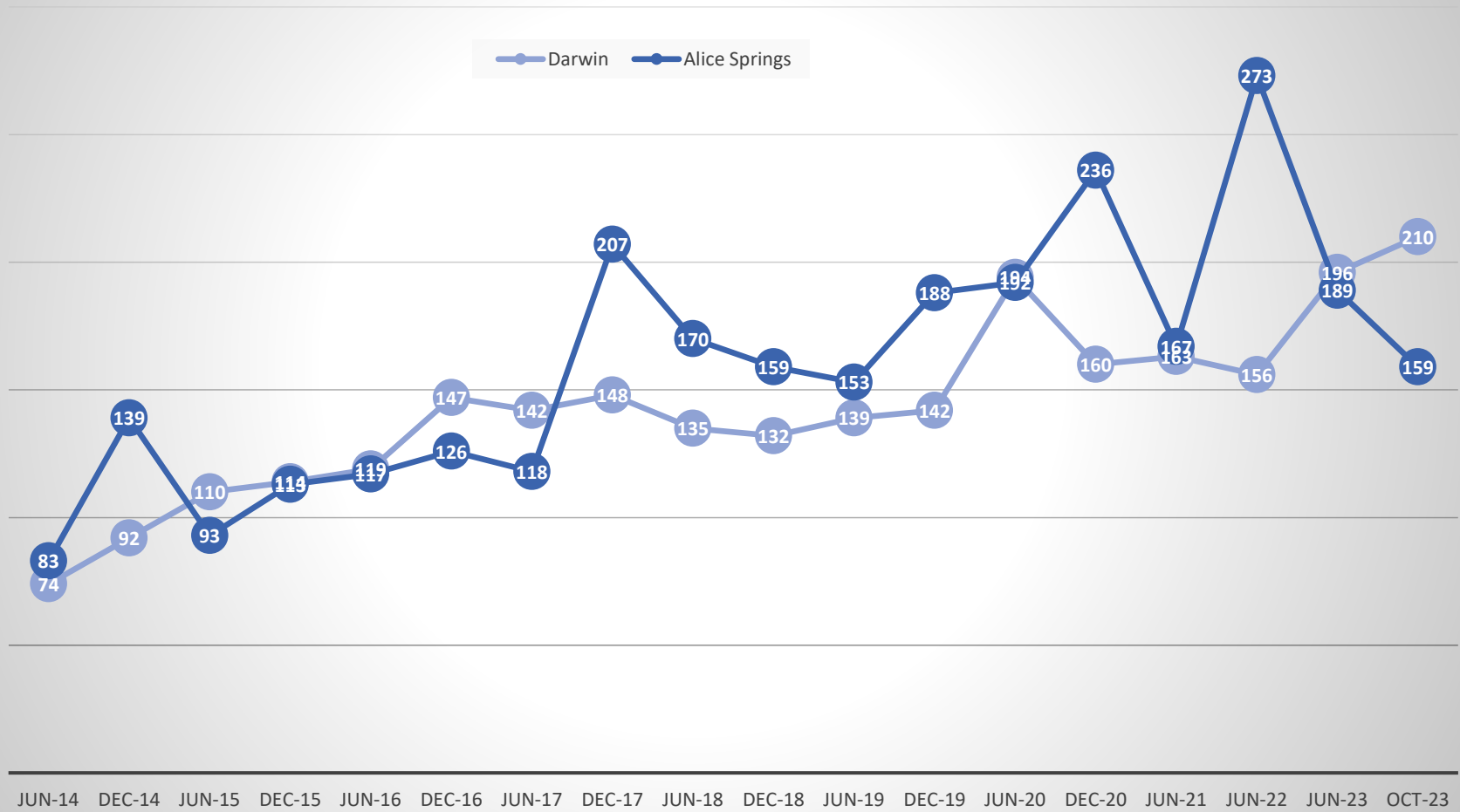
