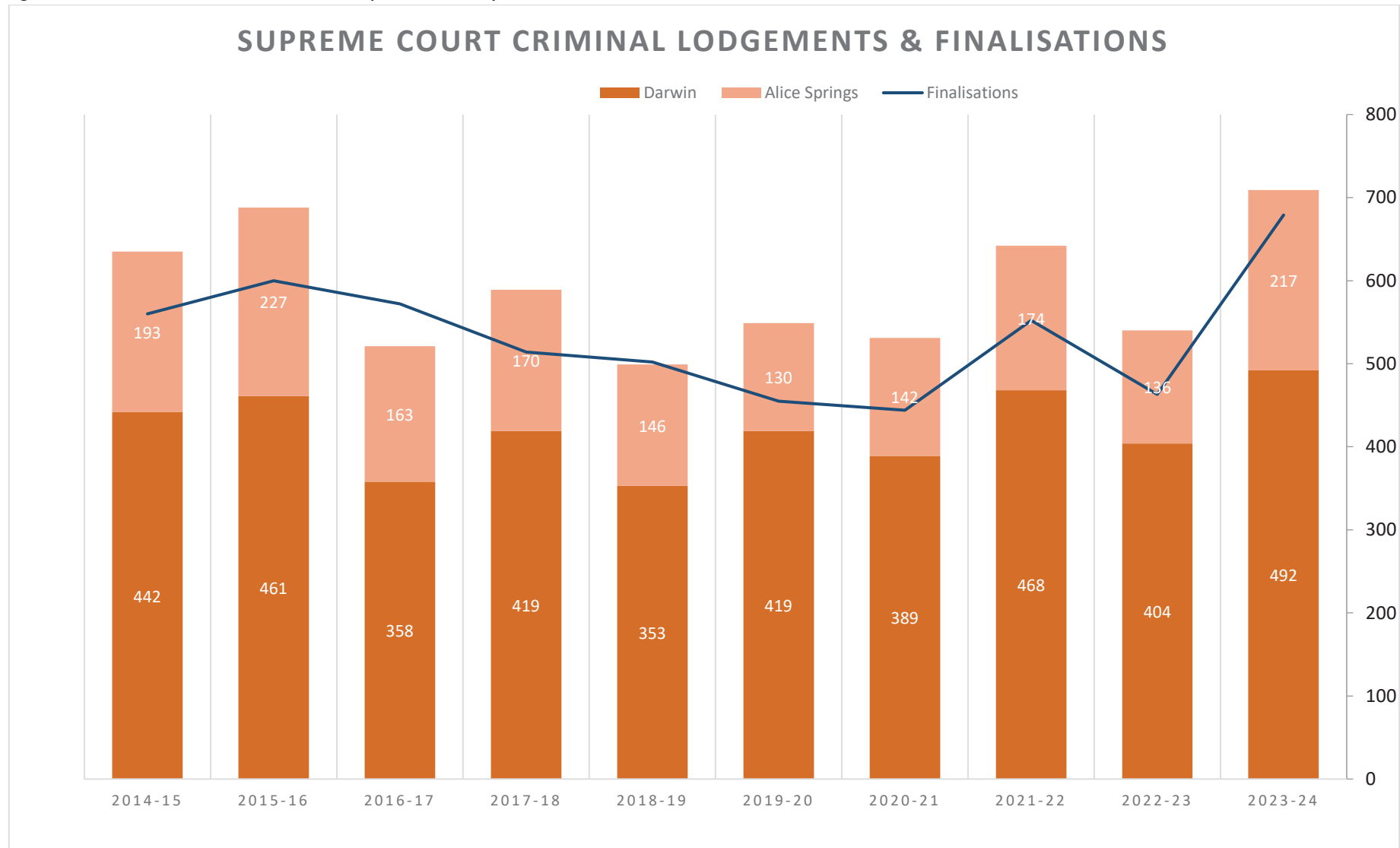

Figures for 2023-24 based on data to end March extrapolated to end of year



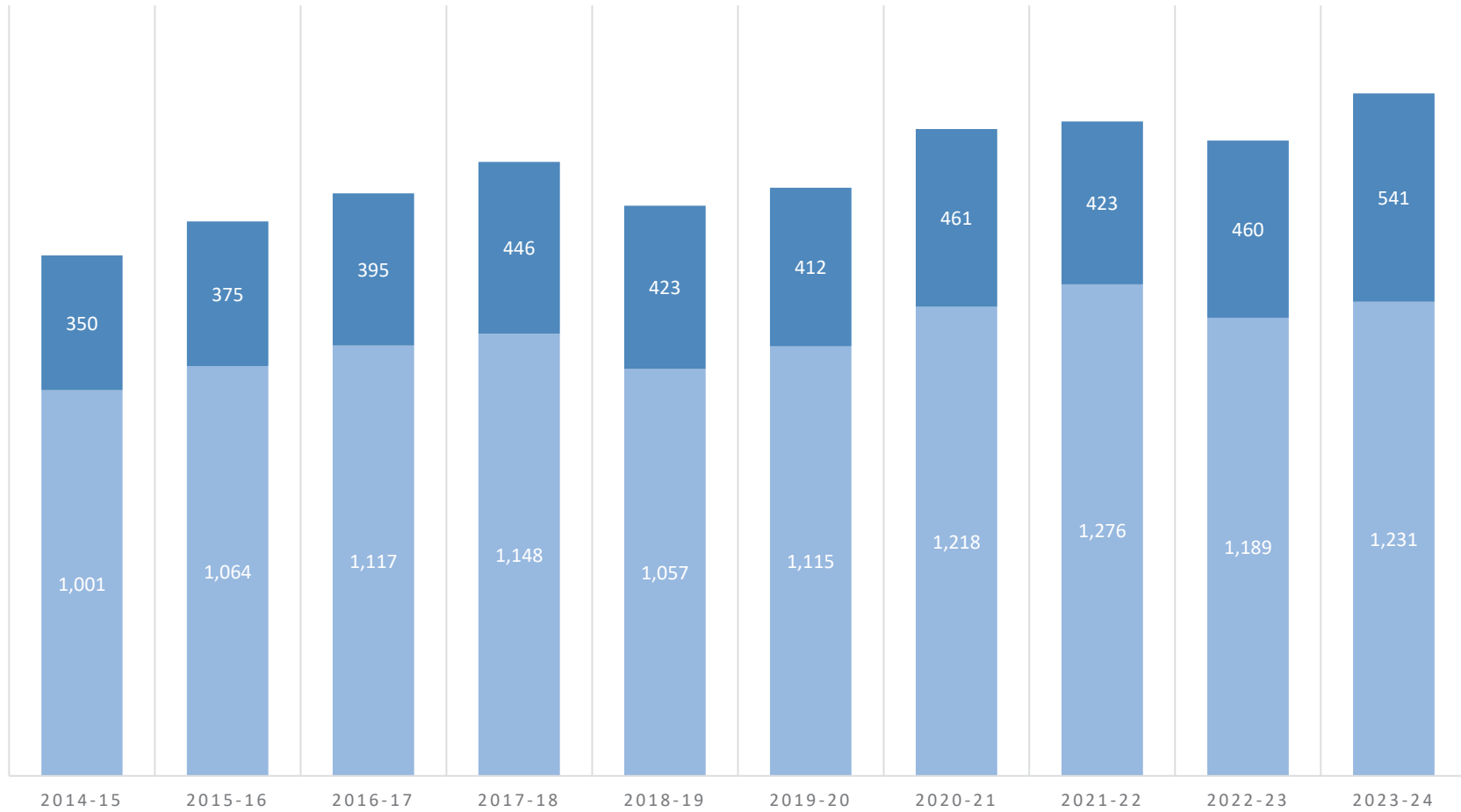

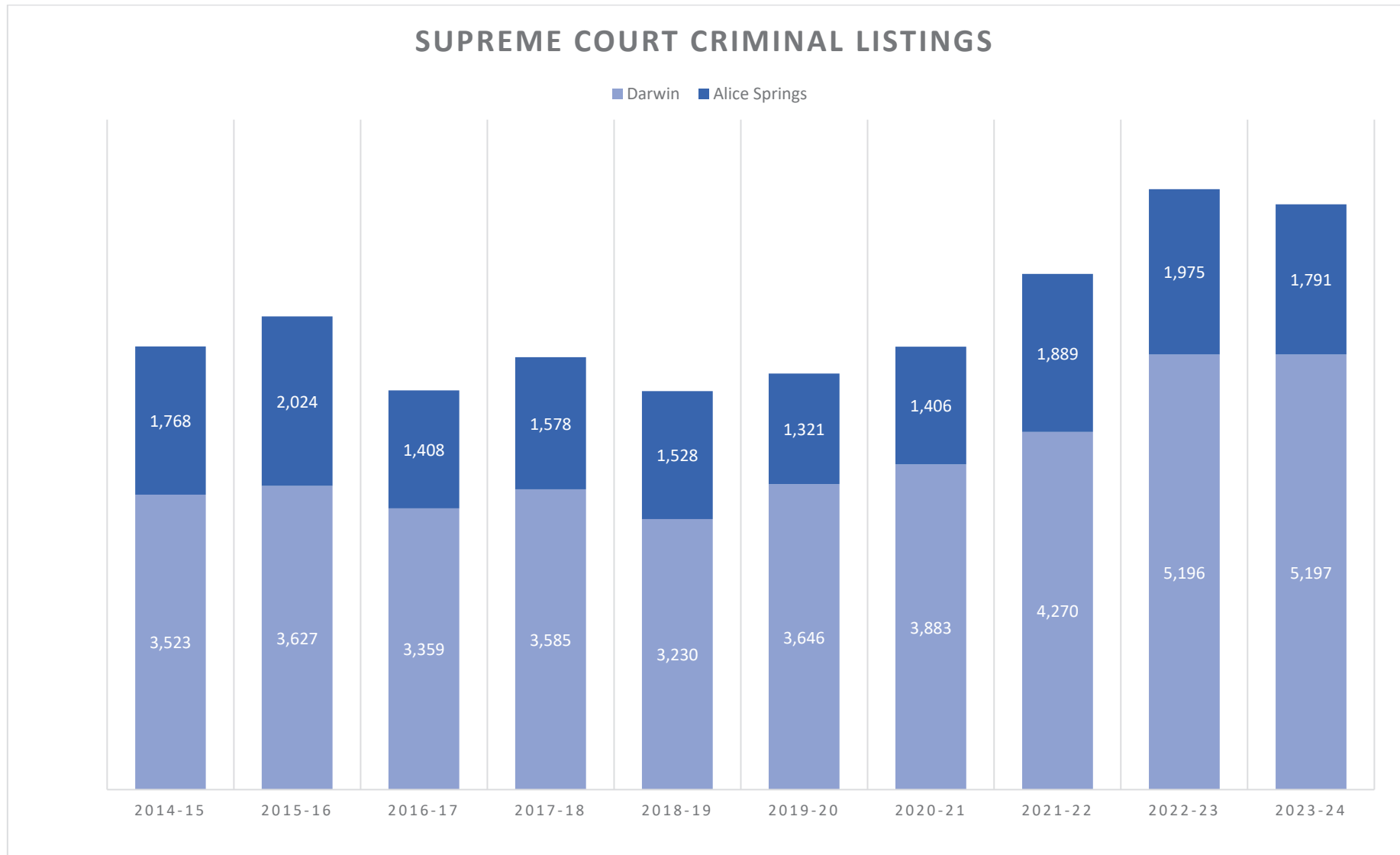

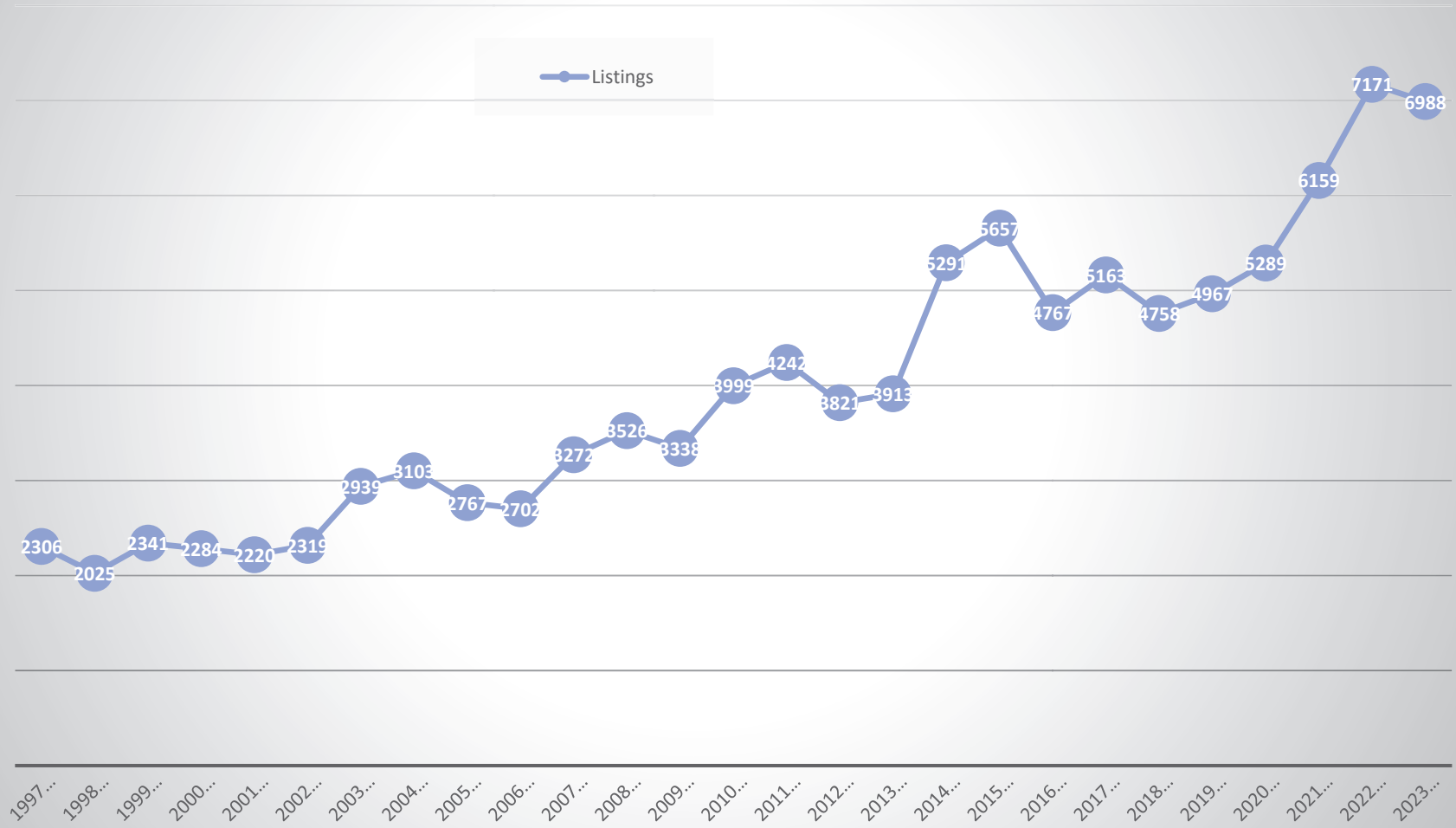

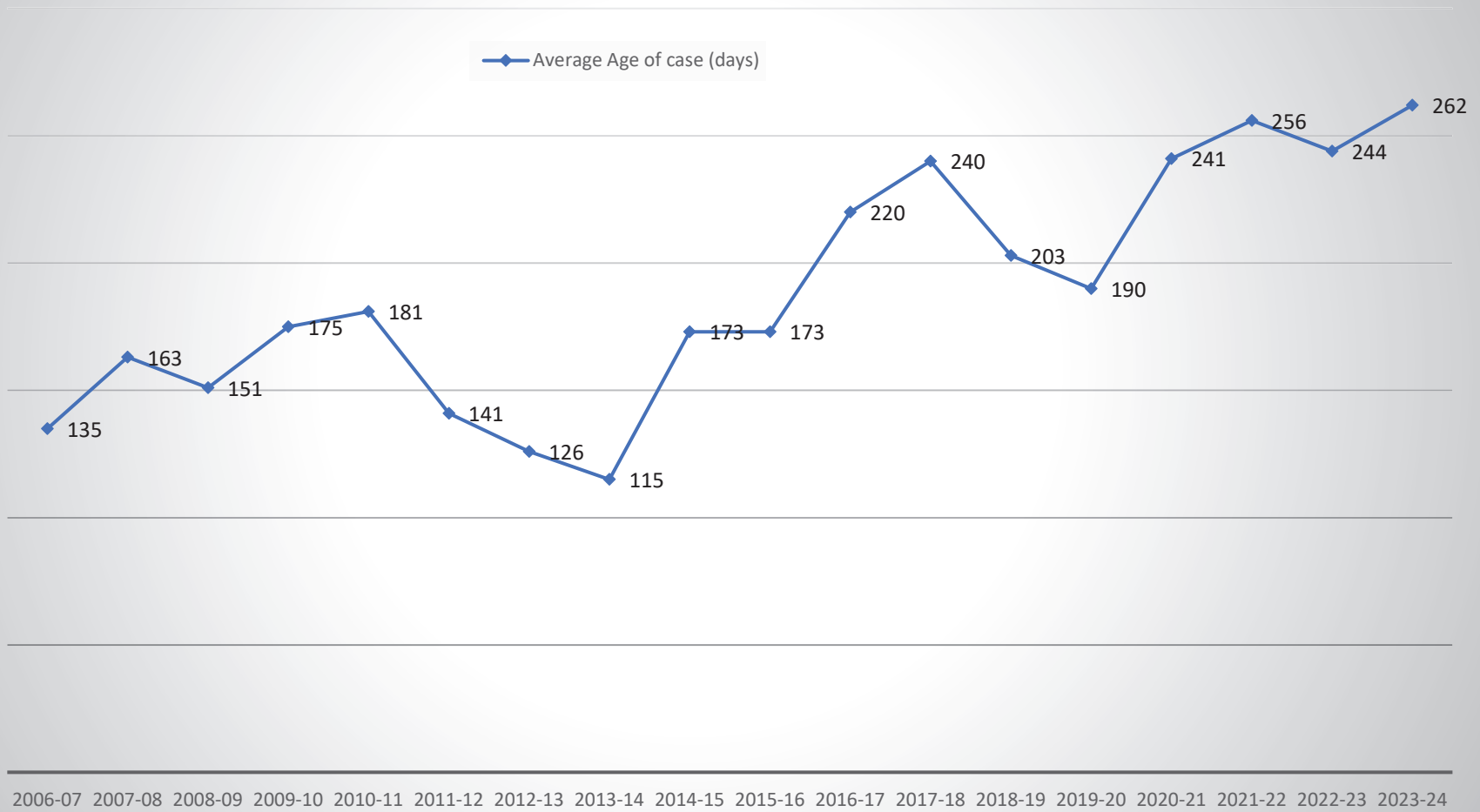

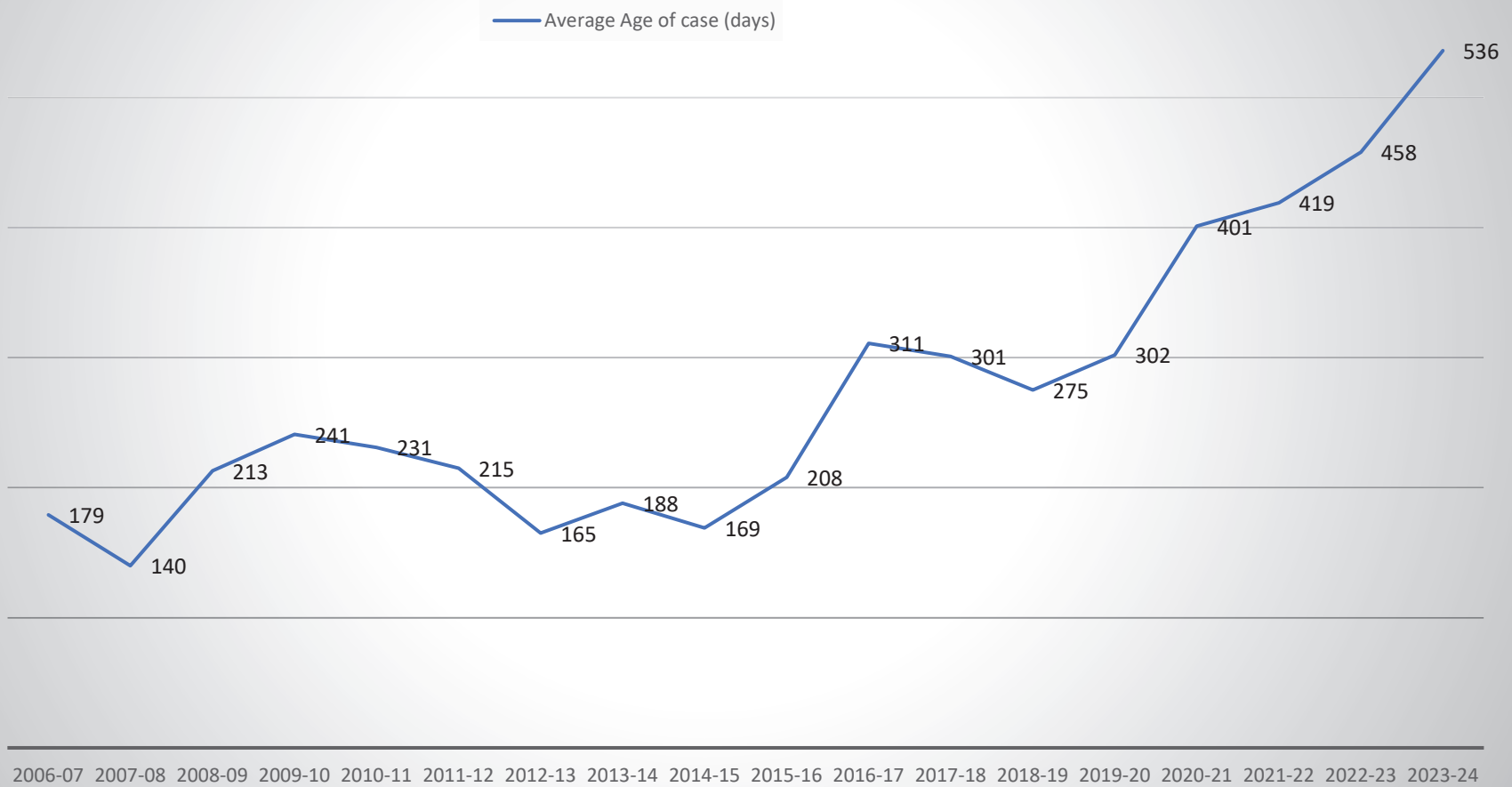

## Supreme Court average time between first mention and finalisation

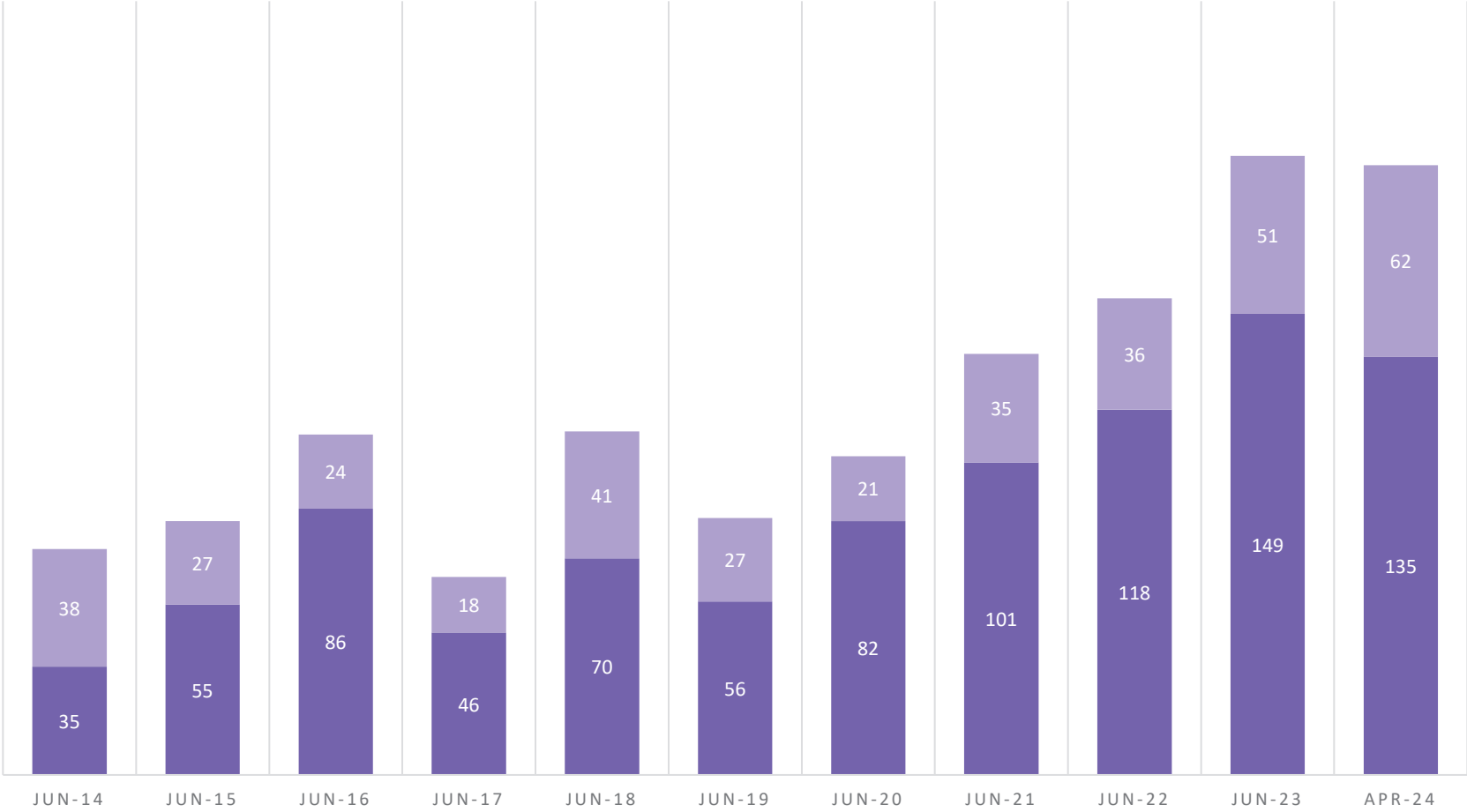


## Supreme Court average time between initiation and finalisation by trial

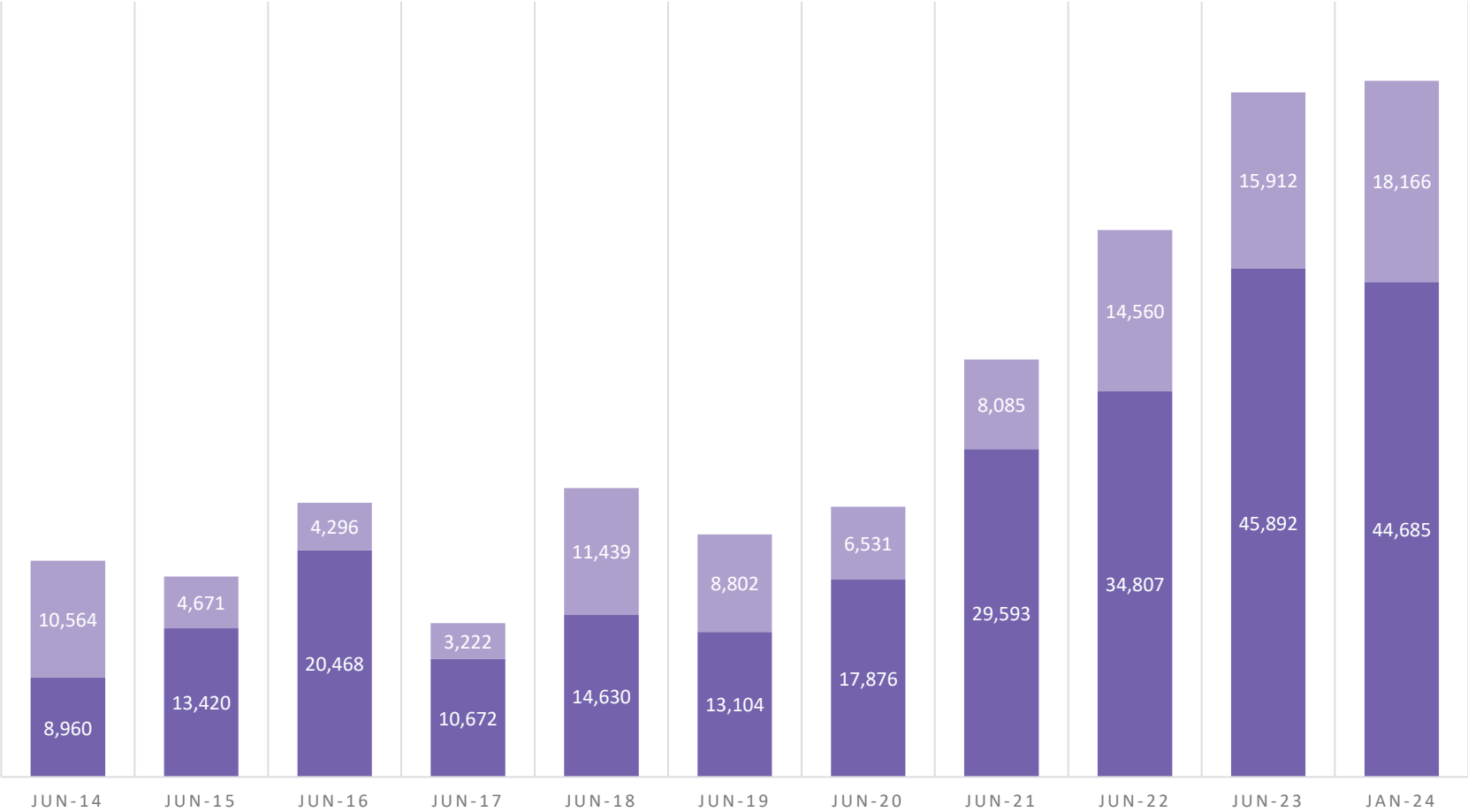


## AVERAGE REMAND TIME (DAYS)

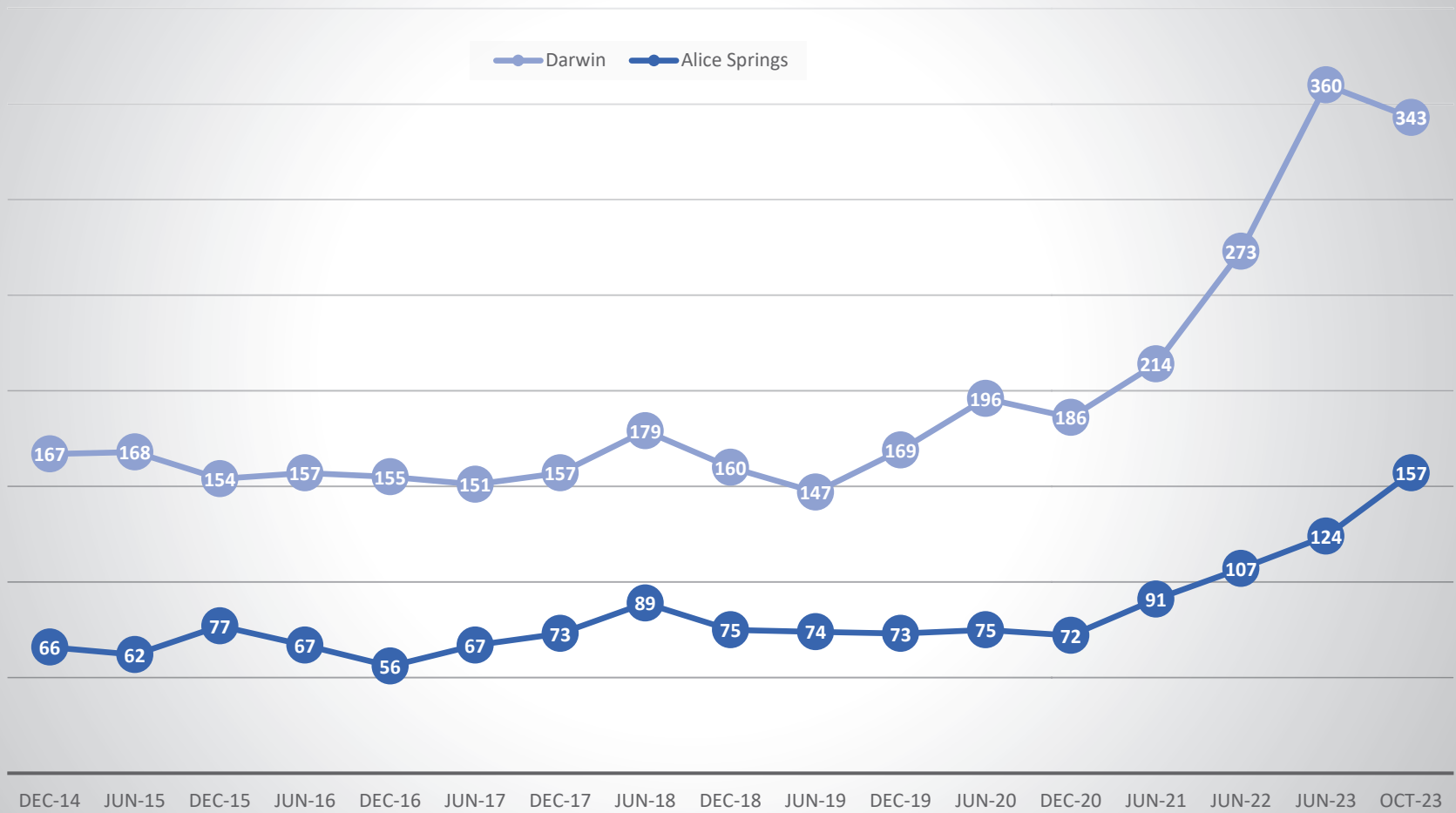


# ACCUMULATED SUPREME COURT REMAND DAYS

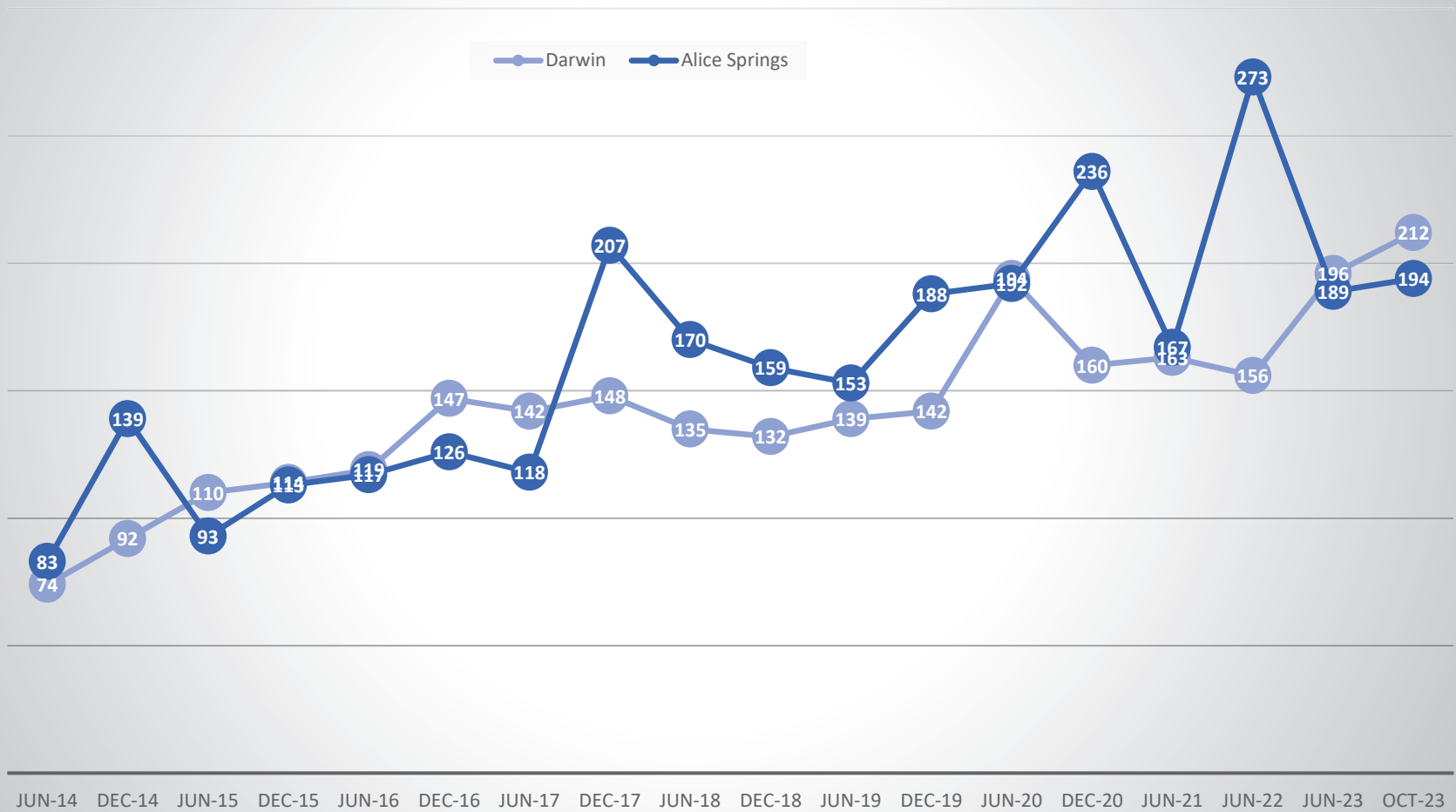
