

52. Practice Direction No 5 of 2008 – List of Authorities and Summaries of Submissions

Practice Direction No 6 of 2001 is rescinded and replaced by the following Practice Direction.

In all proceedings before a single Judge at first instance, if authorities or legislation will be relied upon, a list of authorities and legislation must be filed and served no later than 24 hours before the time the proceeding is to be heard.

In relation to all appeals, practitioners are referred to the time requirements specified in O 84.17. By force of this Practice Direction, Orders 84.17, 84.18 and 84.19 apply mutatis mutandis to appeals to which O 83 applies.

On filing, lists of authorities and summaries of submissions will be sent to the hearing Judge's Associate or, if there is more than one Judge, the senior Judge's Associate, who will arrange to have the authorities available for the use of the Court. In the event that these documents are not filed within time, it will be incumbent on the practitioner involved to notify the Associate as to the reason for the failure, and provide sufficient copies of the authorities for the use of the court.
