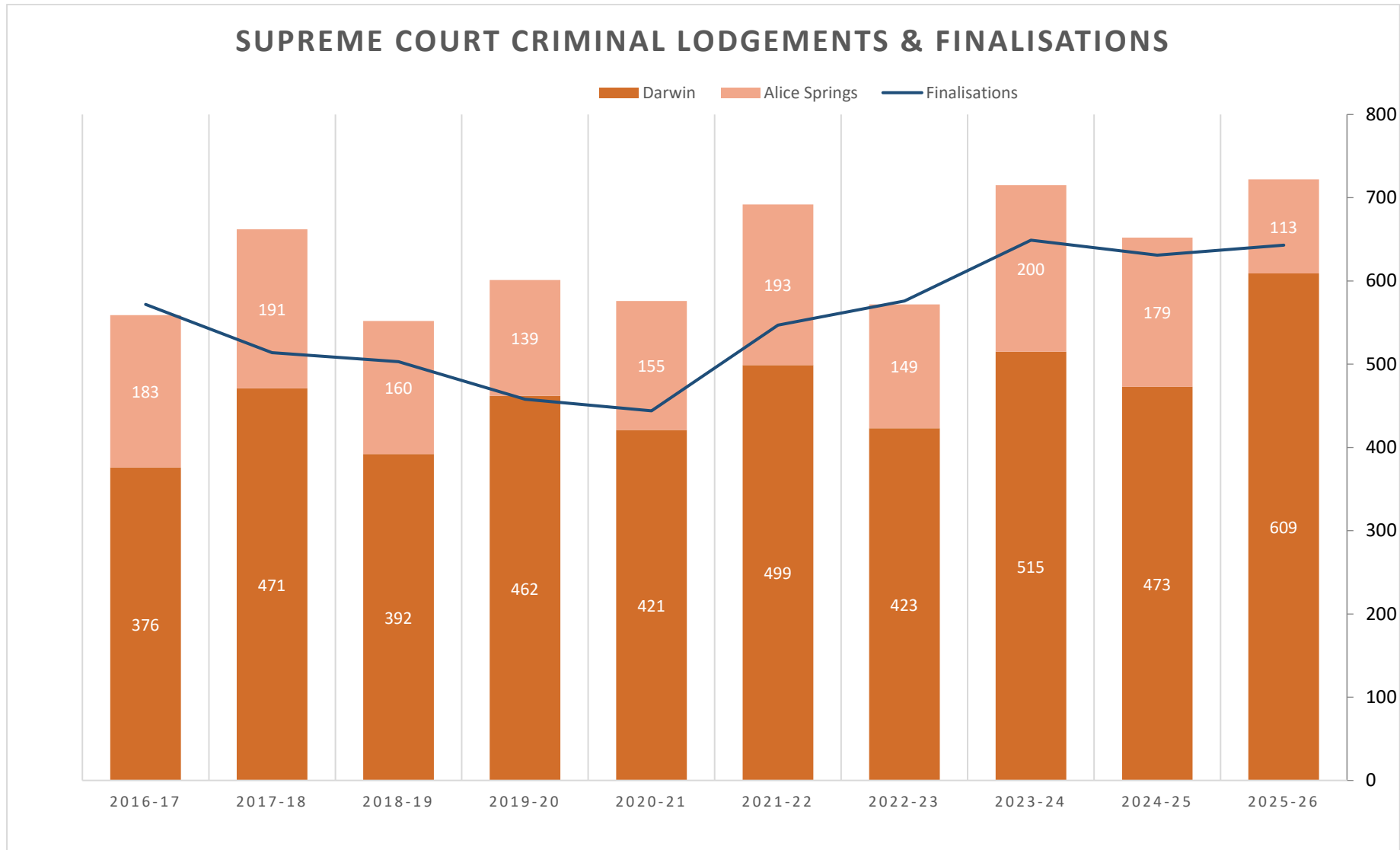


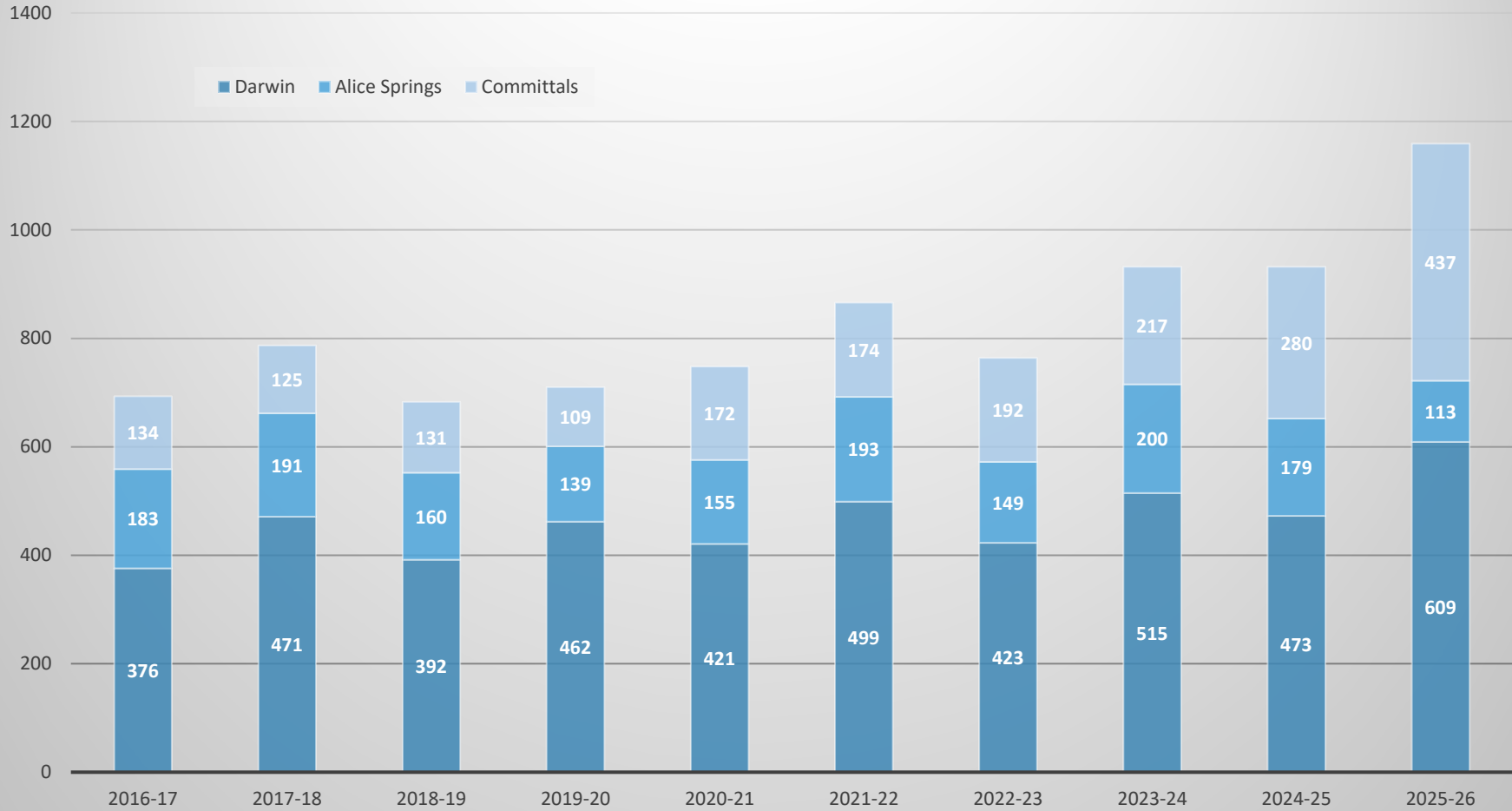

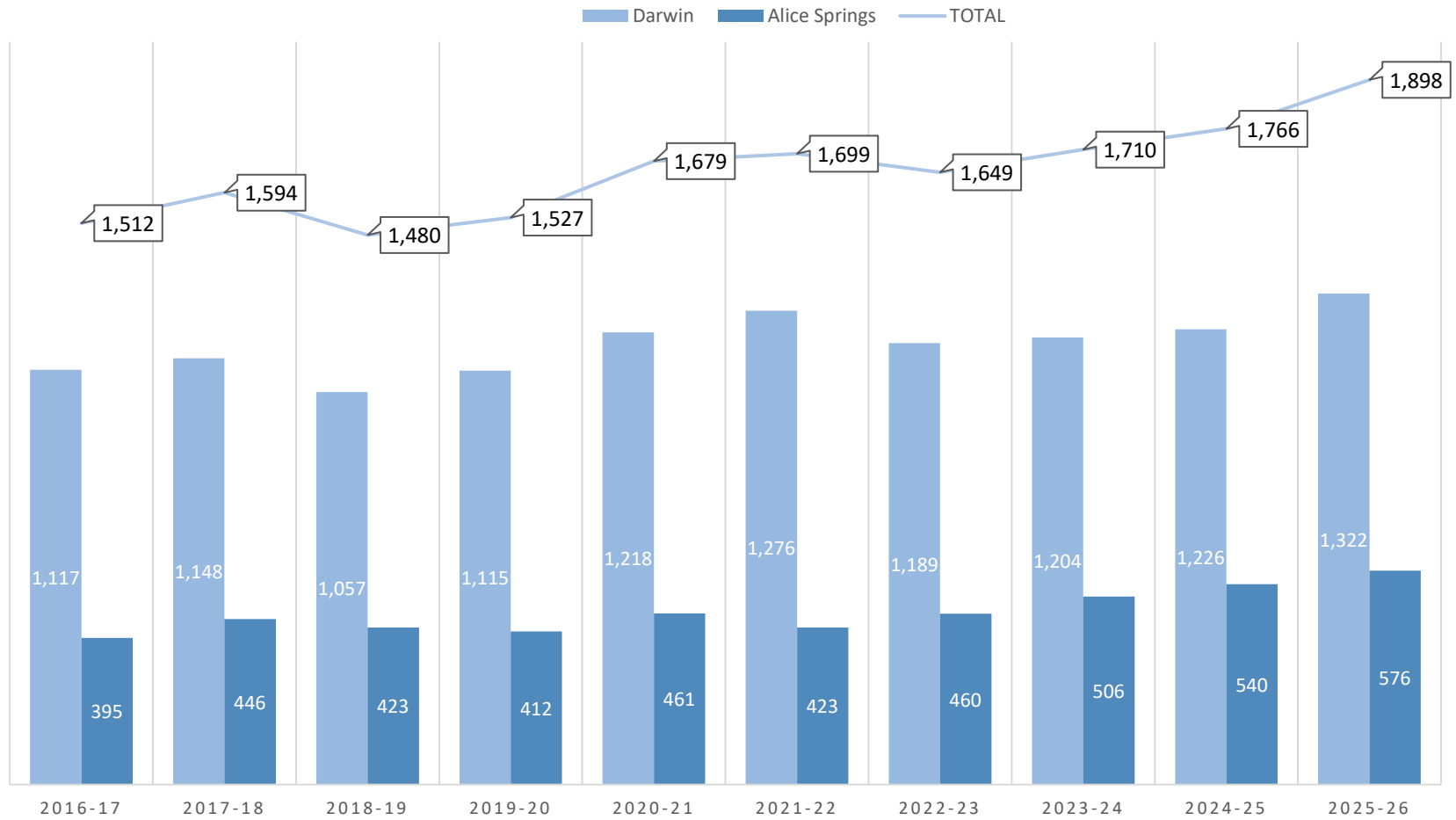

SUPREME COURT CRIMINAL LODGEMENTS WITH OUTSTANDING LOCAL COURT COMMITTALS



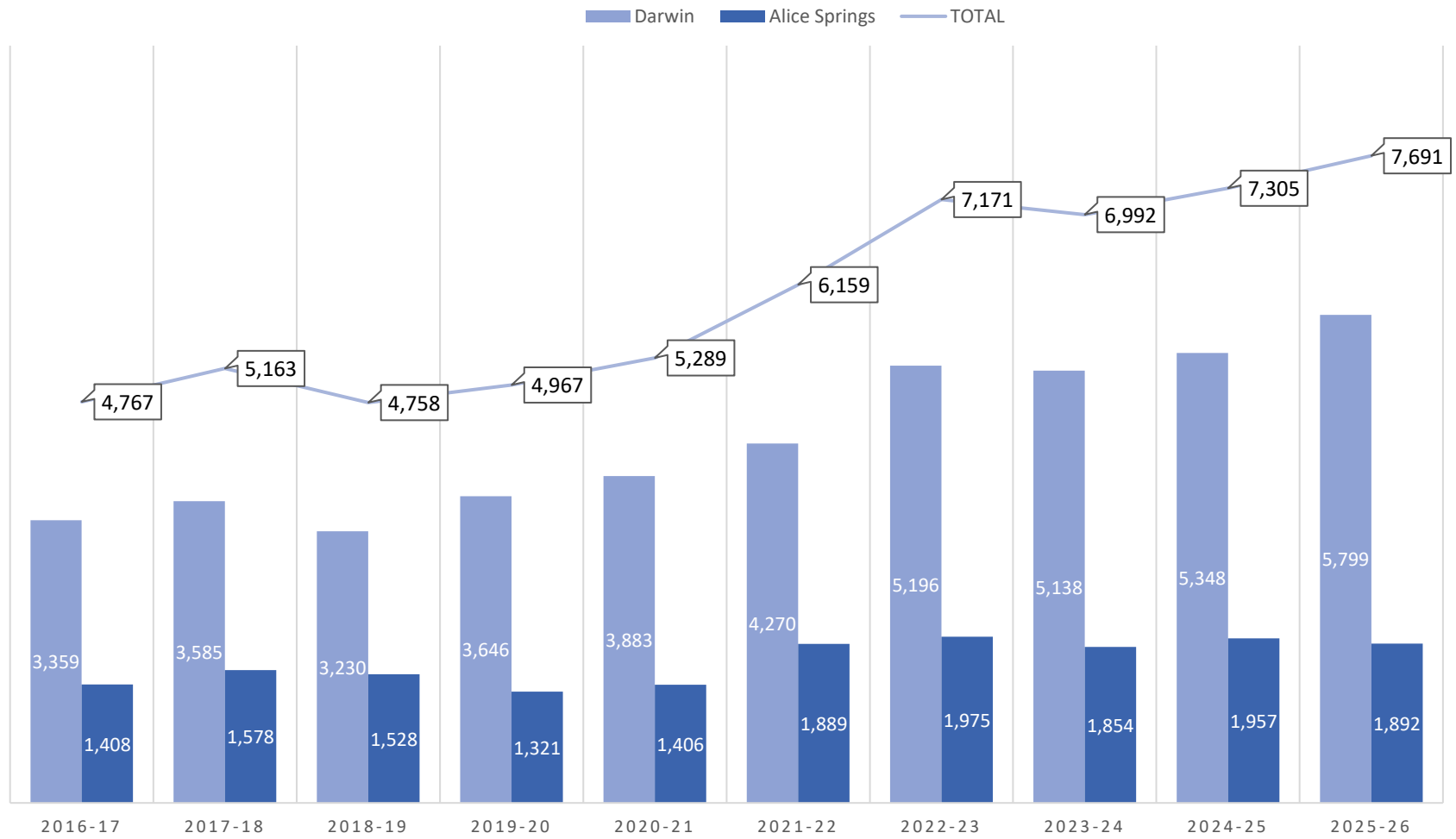

SUPREME COURT CRIMINAL SITTING DAYS

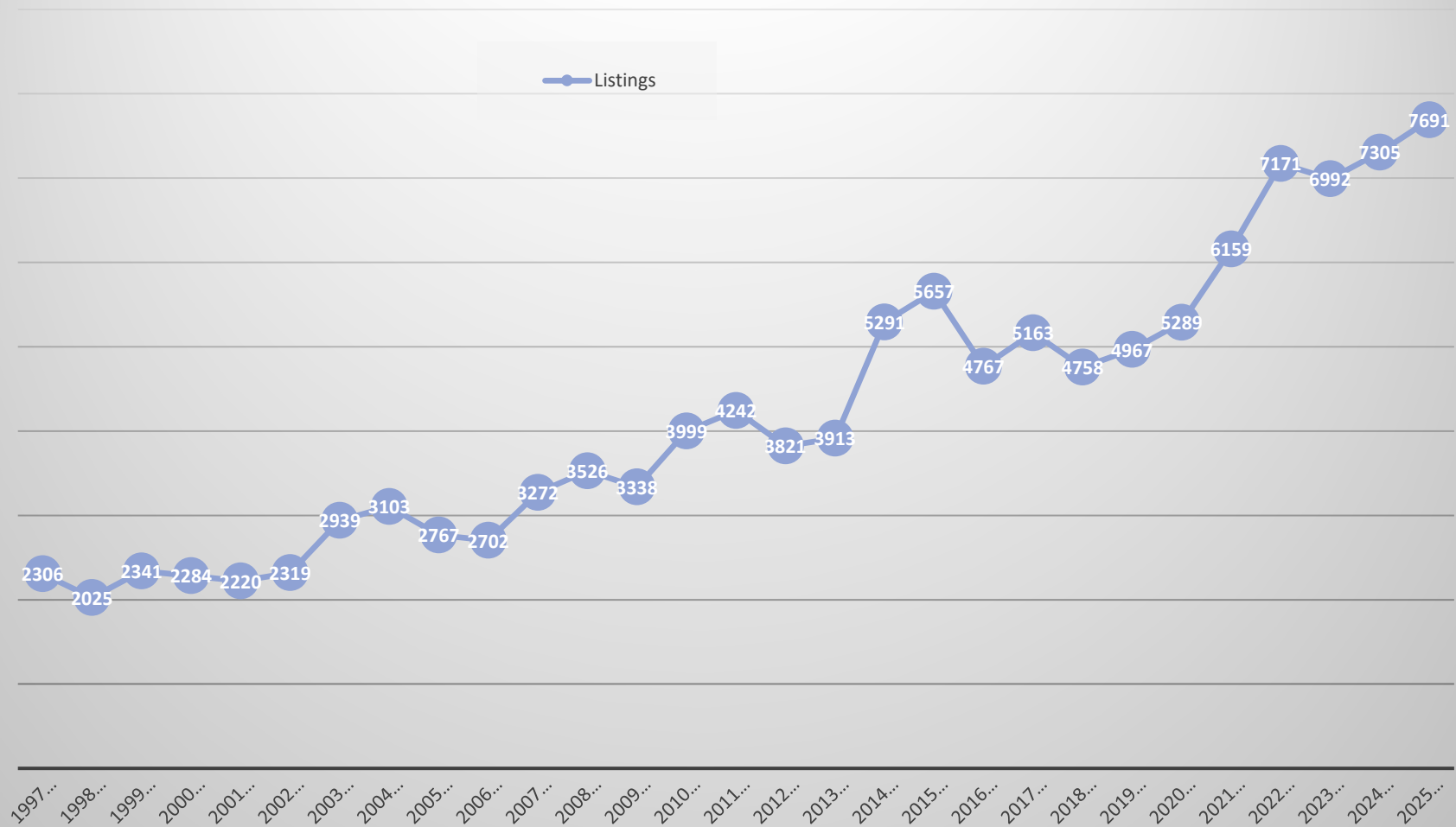

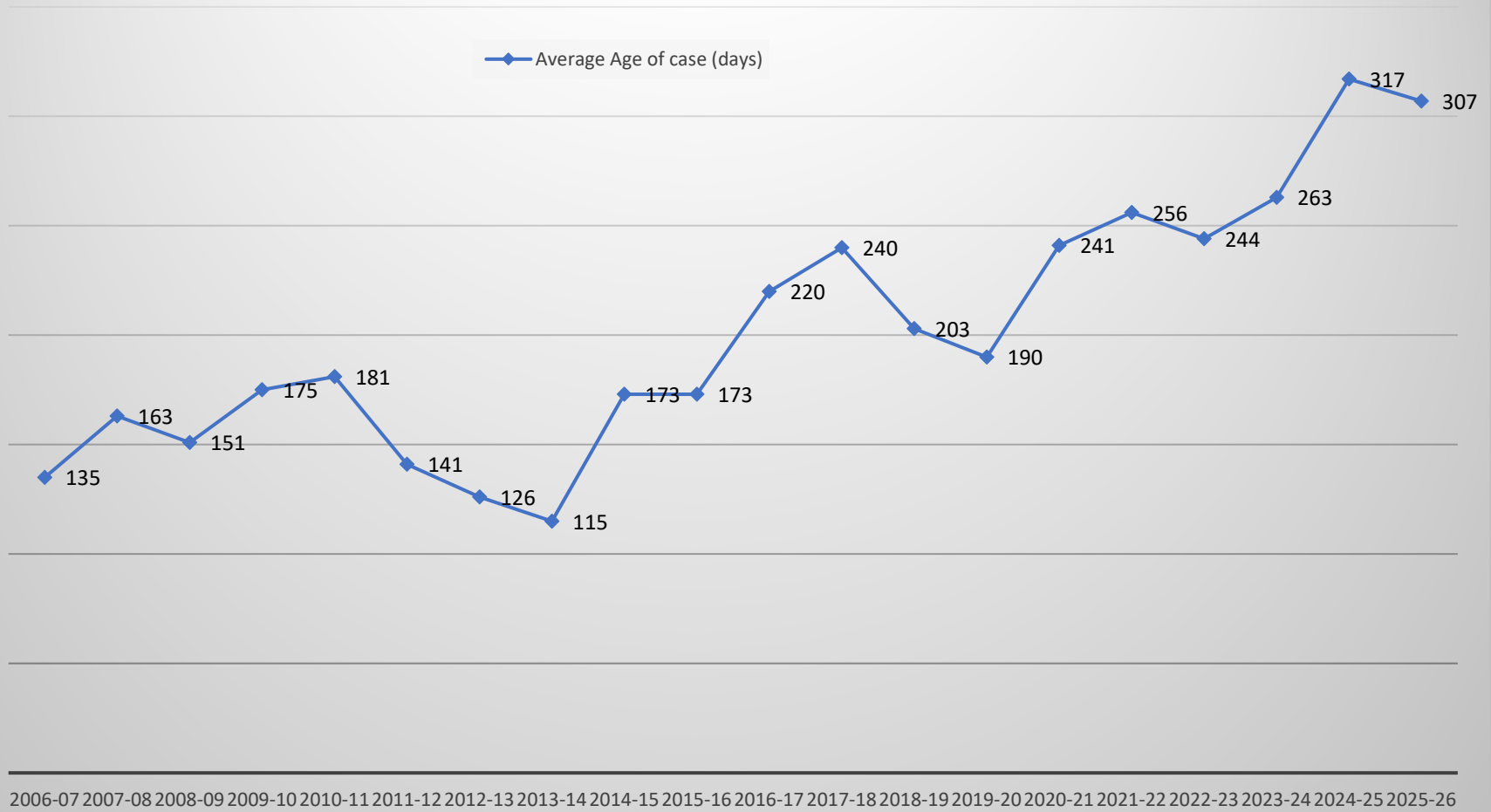


Supreme Court criminal listings 1997 - 2026



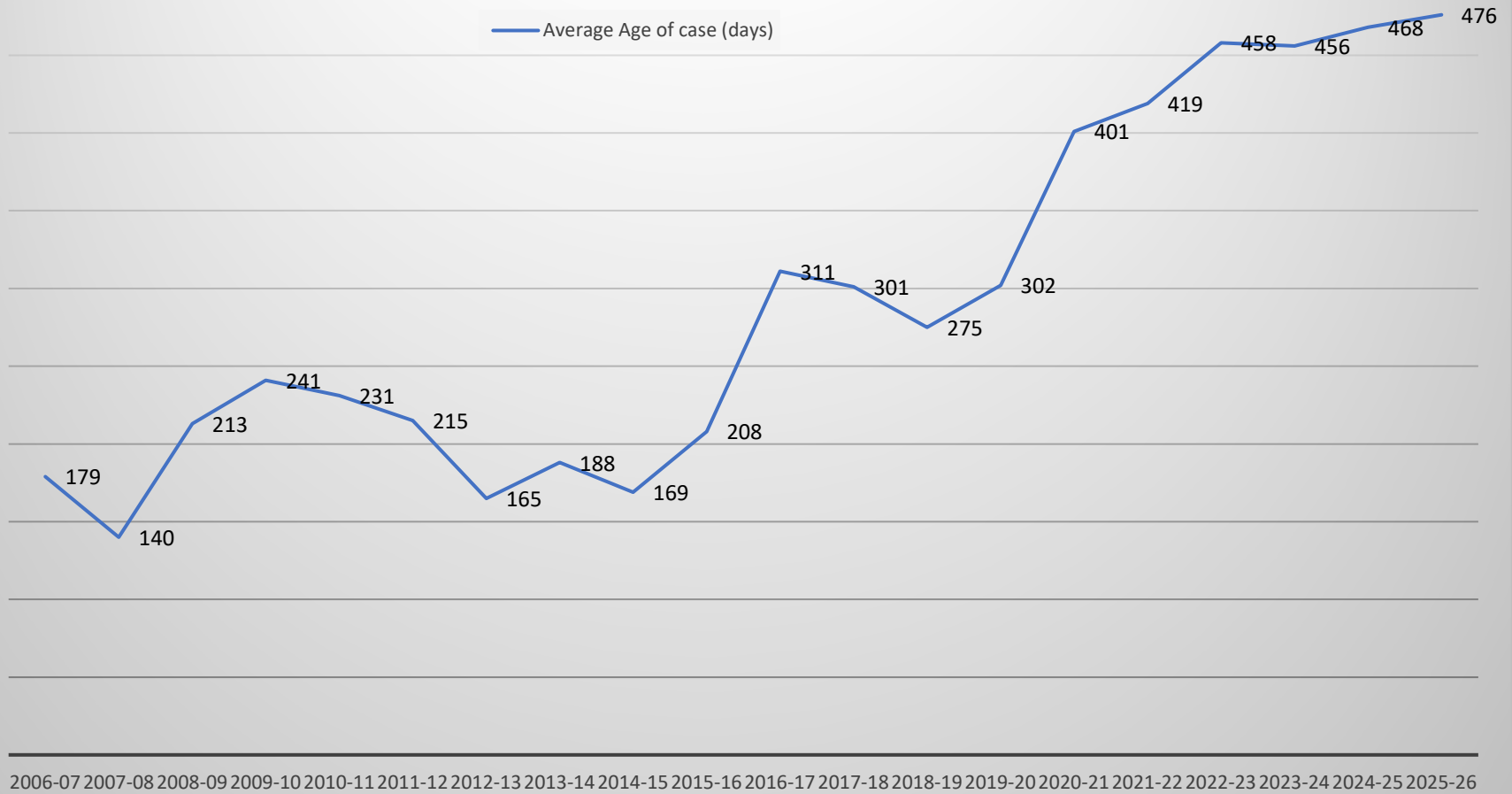
The significance of this table is that 1997 was the last time the number of permanent Supreme Court Judges was increased.

Supreme Court average time between first mention and finalisation



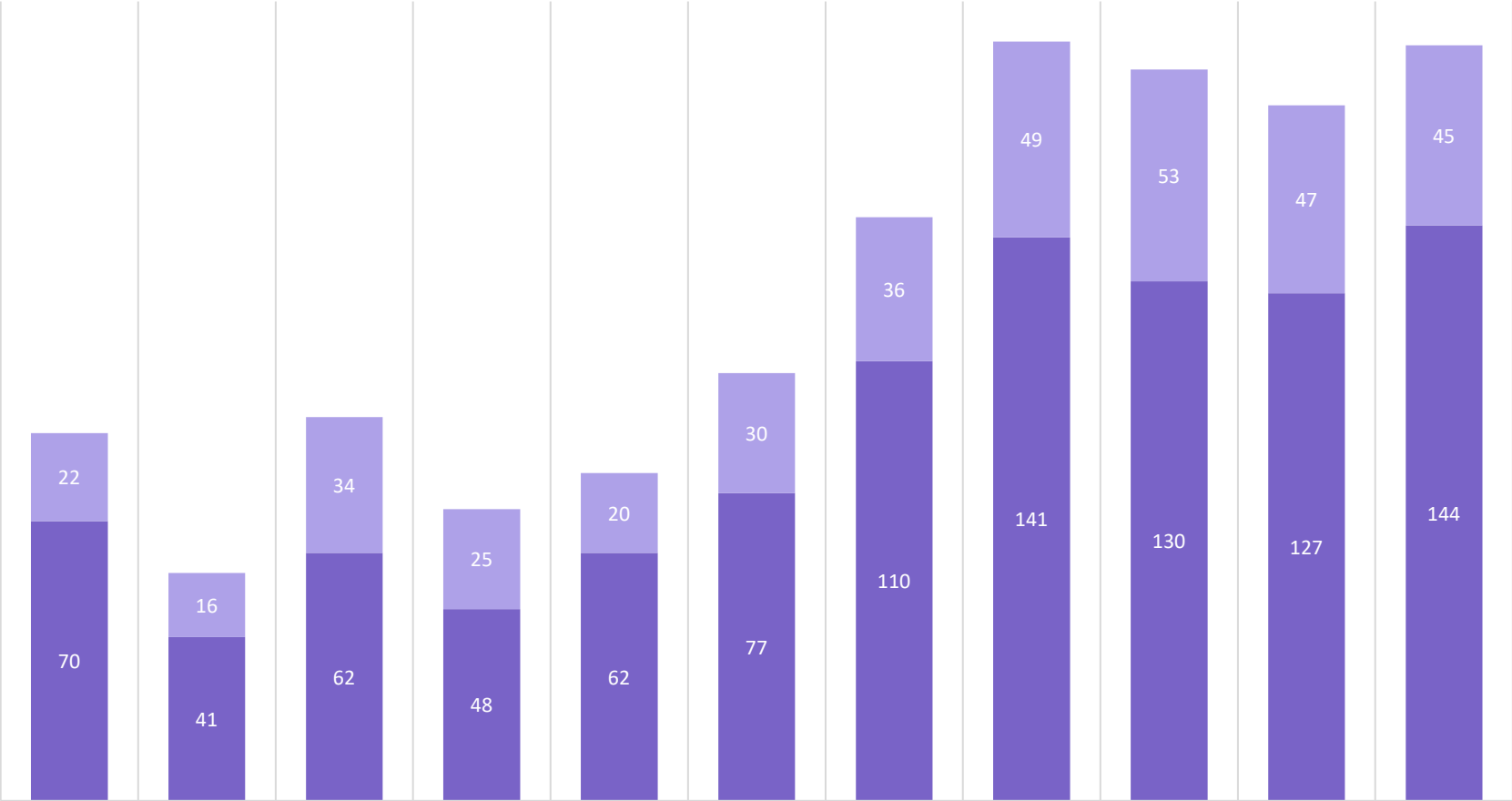

Supreme Court average time between initiation at Local Court and finalisation by trial

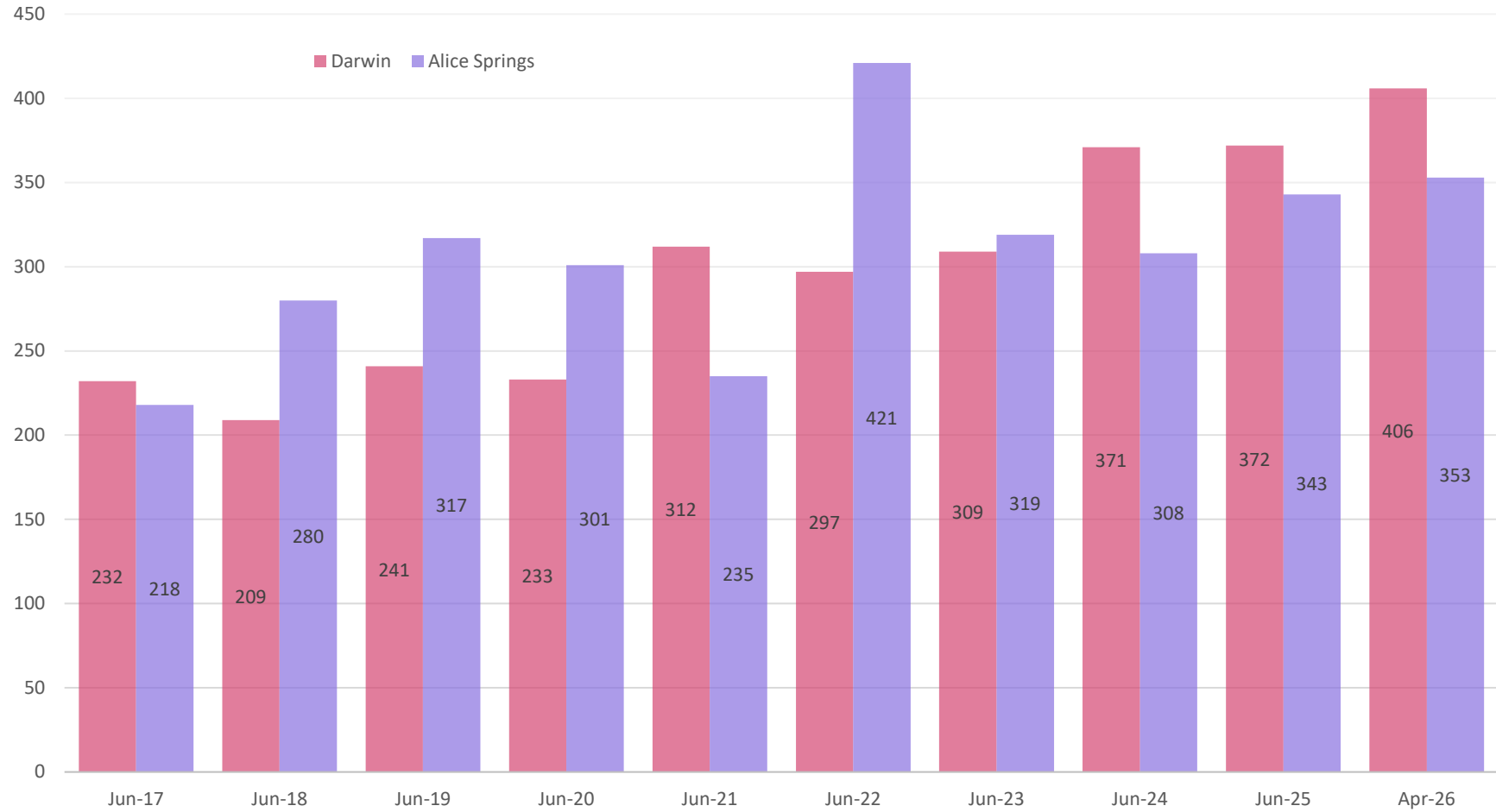

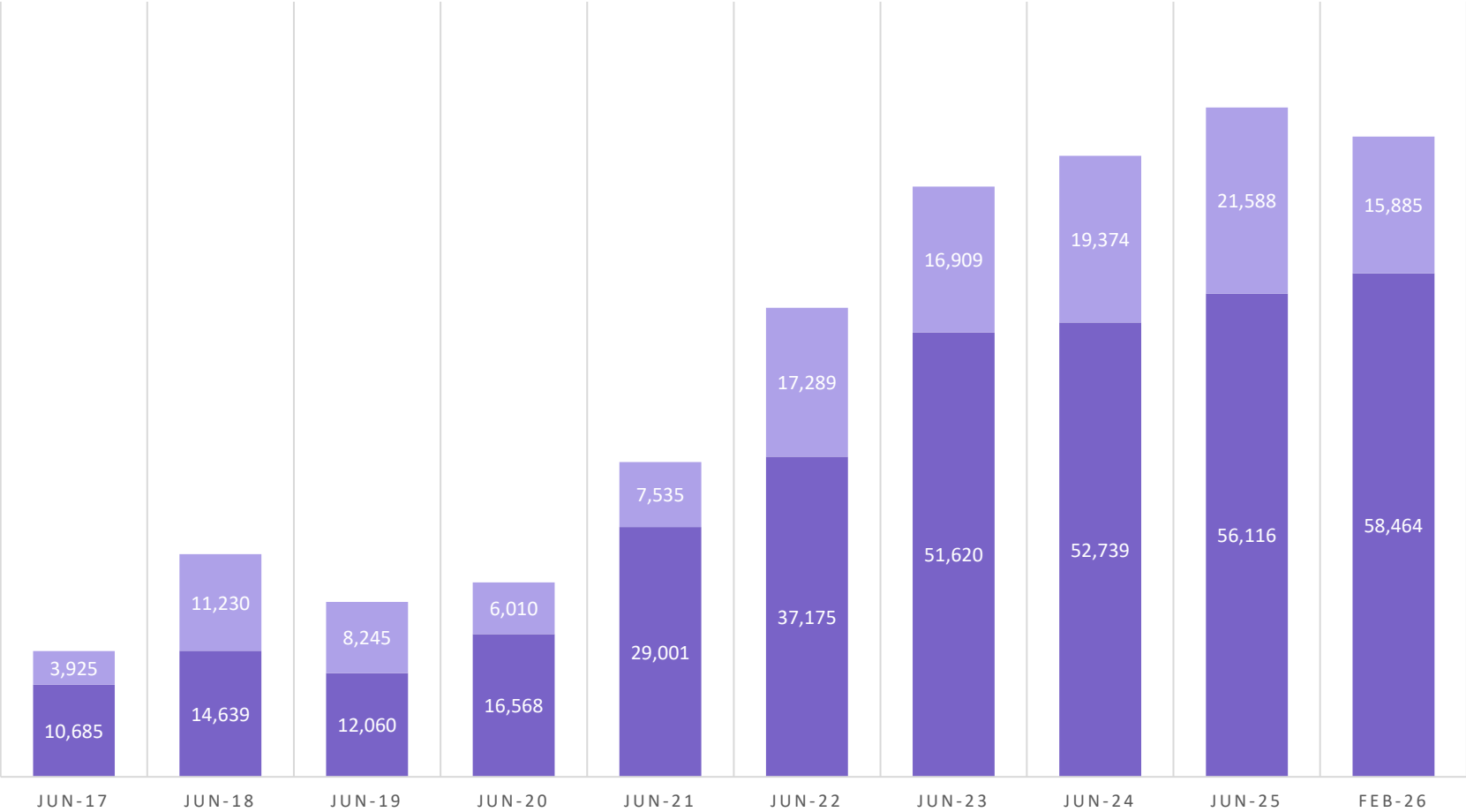
AVERAGE REMAND TIME (DAYS)



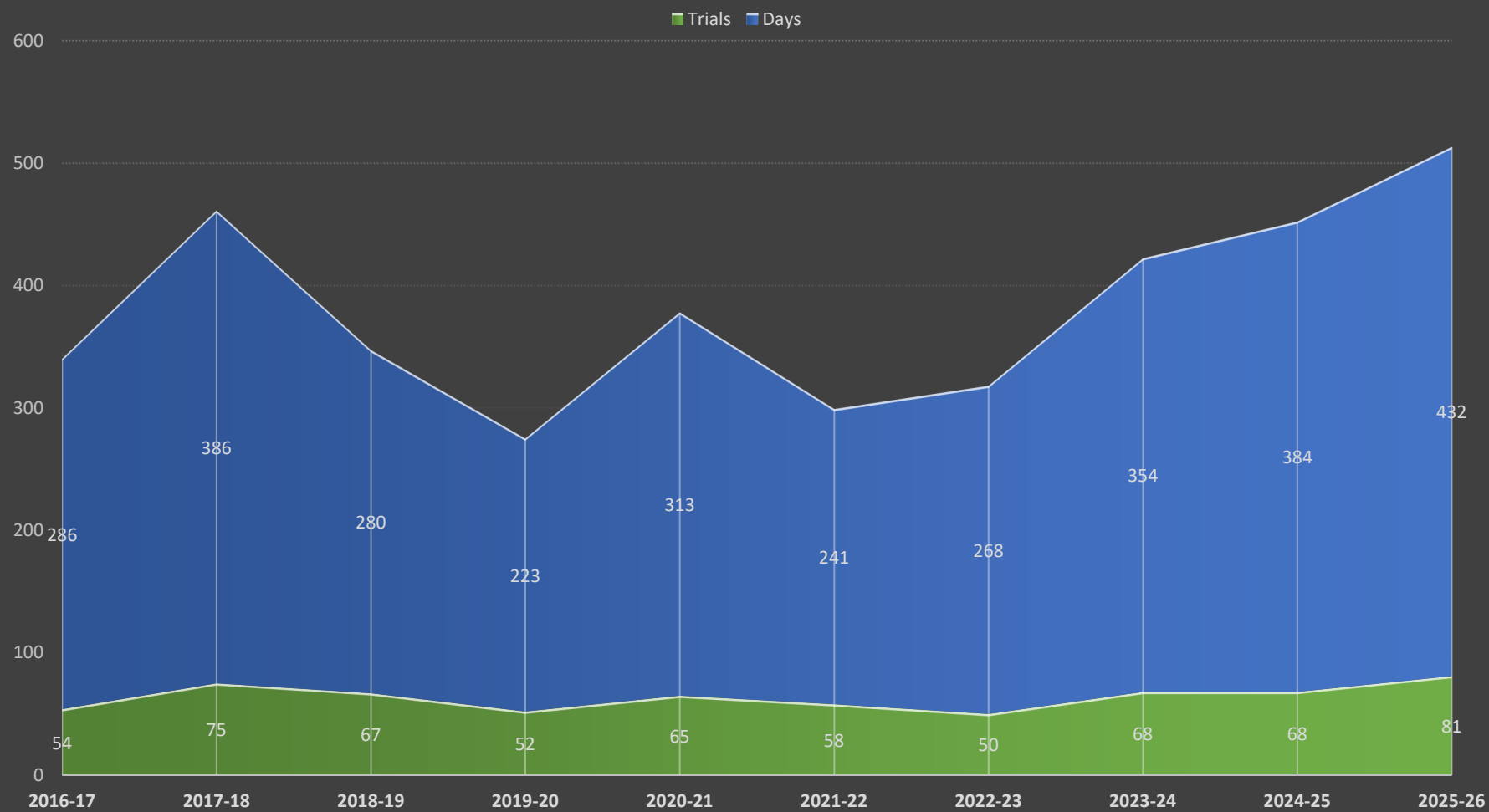

ACCUMULATED SUPREME COURT REMAND DAYS

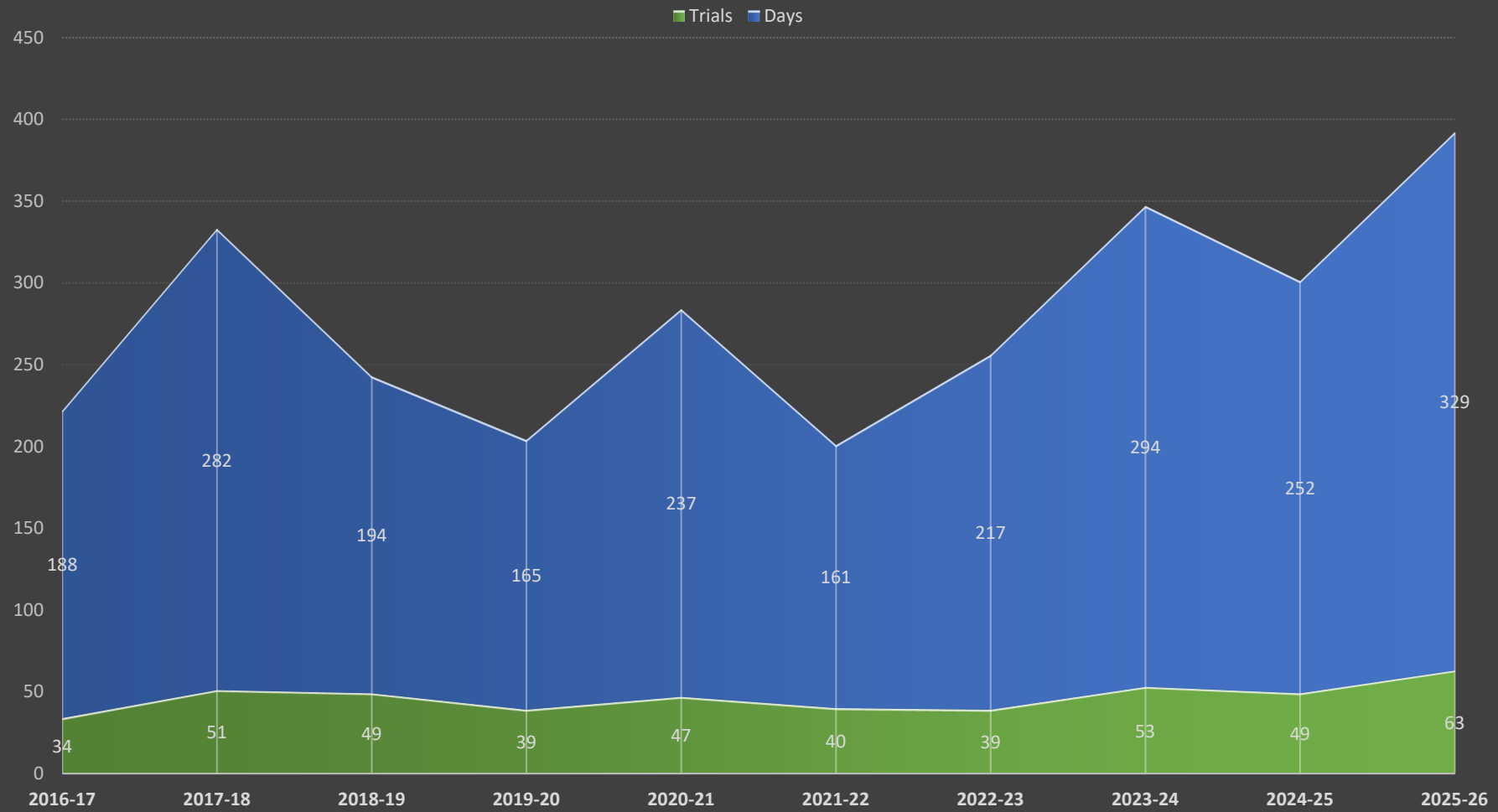

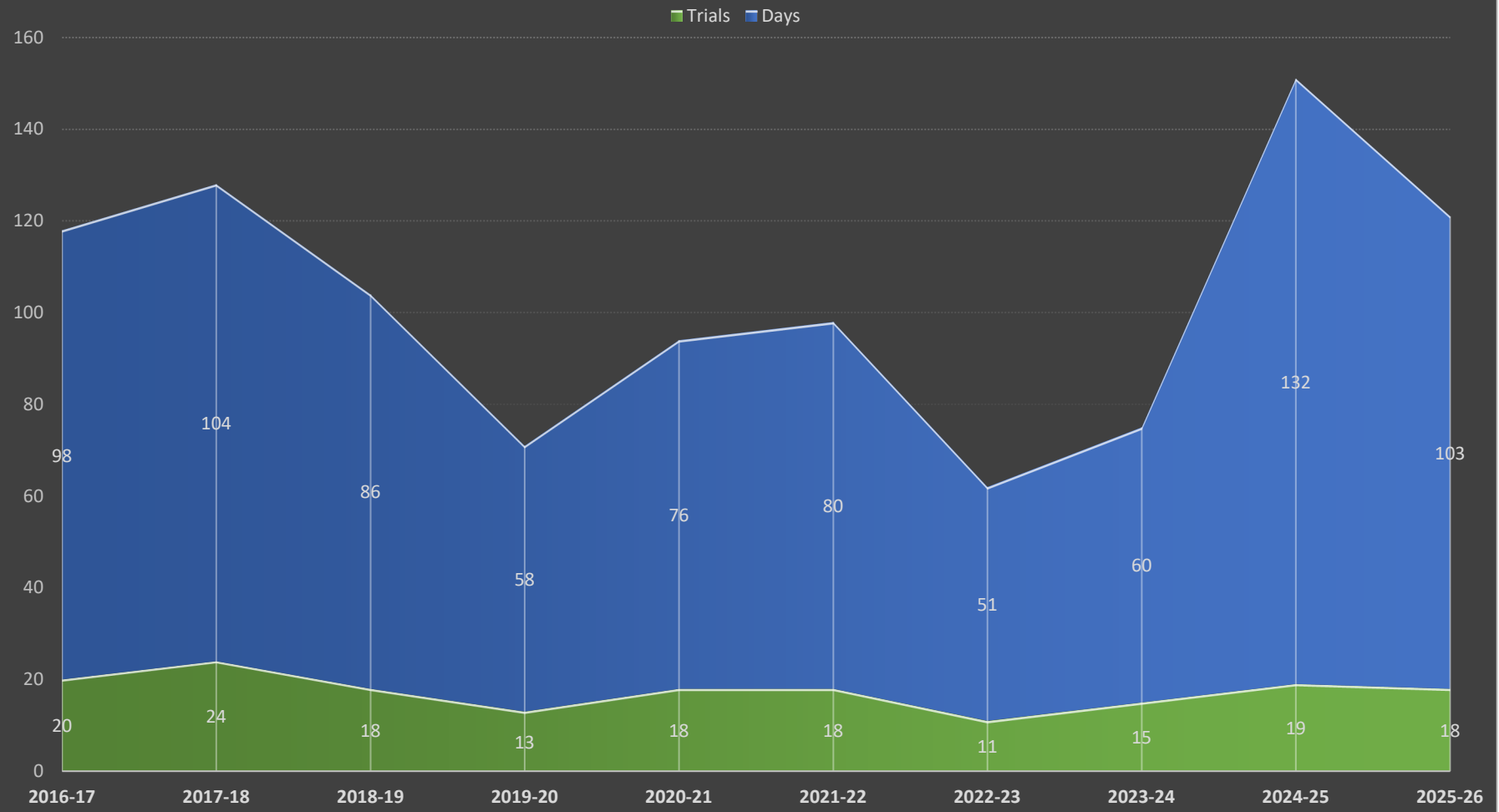
Supreme Court JURY DATA - NT



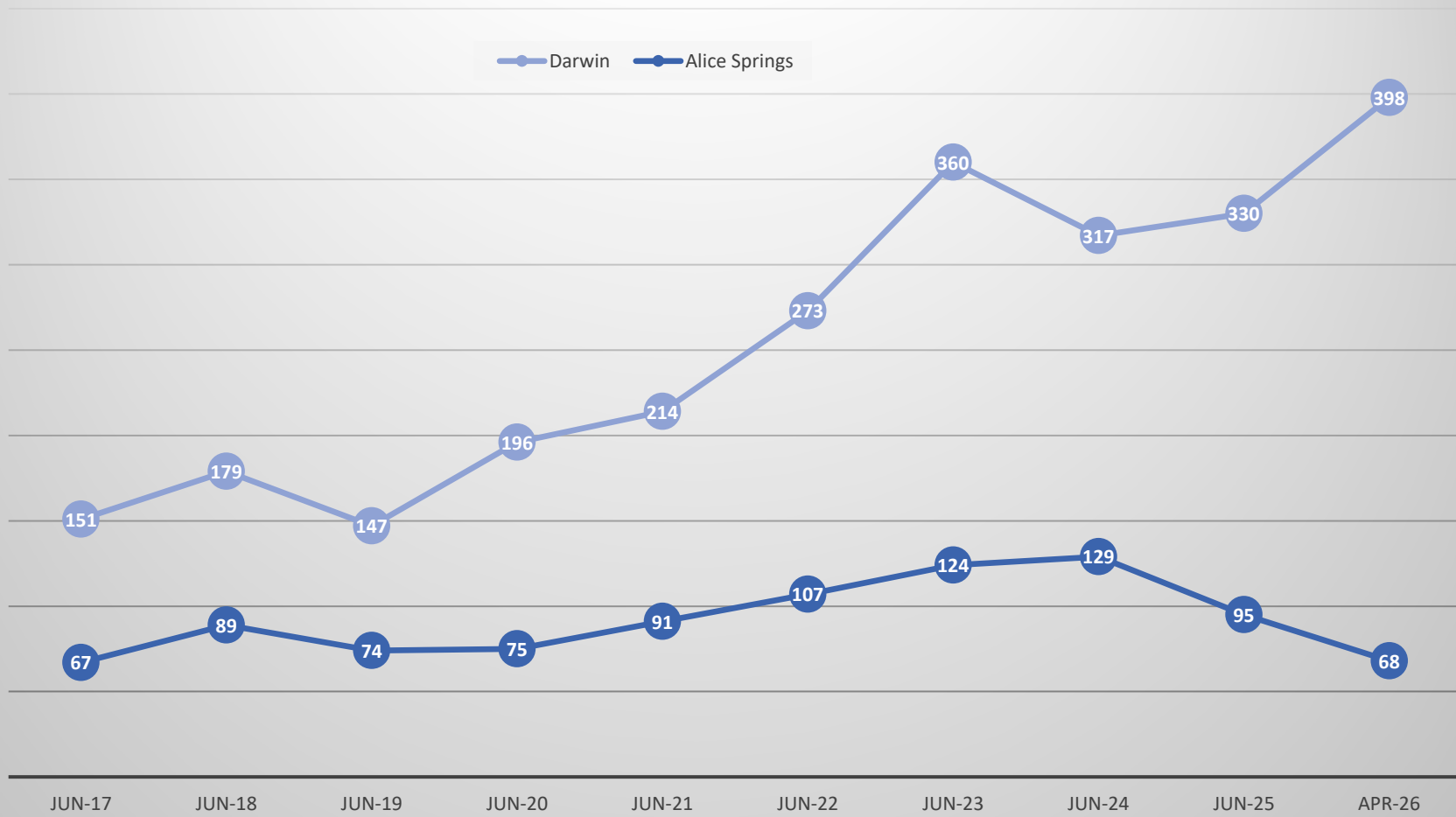
Supreme Court JURY DATA - DARWIN



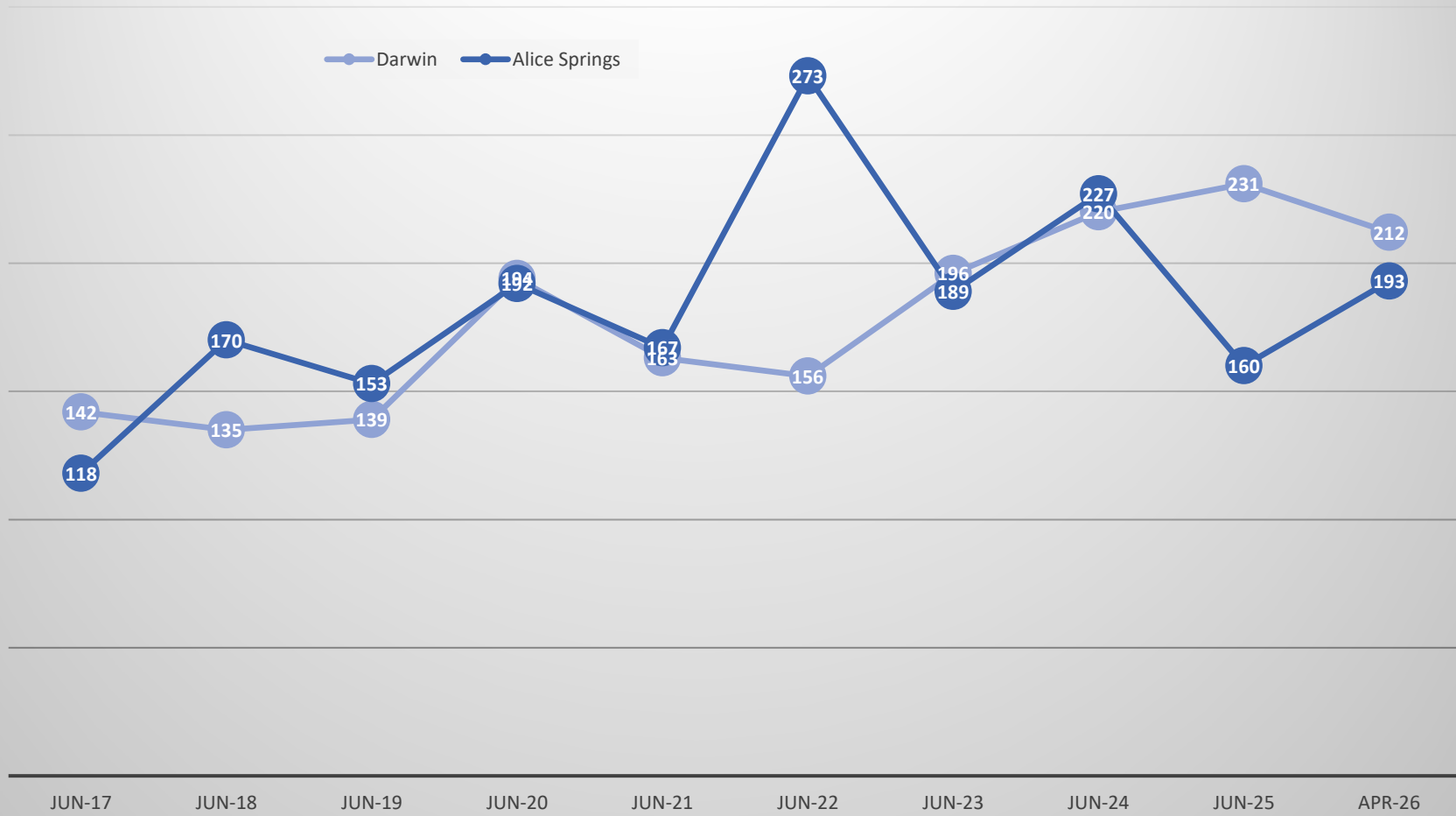
Supreme Court JURY DATA - ALICE SPRINGS
